Grady stated she was at Club 706 with a friend who was holding all of her personal items because she was wearing a dress. Grady stated she went outside b/c she was hot and the security officer gave her a hard time by not letting her back in or that she had to get back in line. She was told she had to leave by the security officer, she advised she had to get her items from the friend. Dep. Forrest showed up and took her to jail and would not allow her to give reason why she needed to go back in club. Grady stated Dep. Forrest was rude and abused his arrest powers. Dep. Forrest told her to shut up and turned his music up really loud while she was in the back of his patrol car.

Supervisor/Investigative Comments.

Citation 268705 under case # 20-019608. Sgt. Lee reviewed body cam video and observed Dep. Forrest was professional and polite saying "please stop talking" and "be quiet please." Grady interrupted Dep. Forrest multiple times when he tried explaining the reason for the arrest.

Dear Nekisha Grady,

On January 28, 2020, you filed a complaint via phone against Deputy Alphonso Forrest alleging the following:

- Deputy Forrest was rude by telling you to shut up, and he also turned his music up really loud while you were being transported to the jail
- Deputy Forrest did not tell you the reason for the arrest or ask for your Identification.

Upon conducting an internal investigation, I reviewed Dep. Forrest's body camera video and observed he was polite and respectful. Dep. Forrest never said "shut up" but instead stated "Please be quiet" and "Thank you." Dep. Forrest tried explaining the reason for the arrest multiple times but was constantly interrupted by you. Dep. Forrest did not violate the Richmond County Sheriff's Office policy. In conclusion, this incident will be closed with a final disposition of Unfounded.
