Danko, along with Dep's. Sanford Corbit and Jason DeArman were working a funeral at Woodlawn United Methodist Church, 2220 Walton Way, when someone transmitted over their CB radio in an inappropriate manner. The transmission was something to the affect of "someone kicking someone's ass." This transmission was also heard over the PA system in the church during the funeral. Upon investigation the three deputies in question told Maj. Weaver that it wasn't them and they didn't know who it was. Upon further investigation, and several days later, Dep. Danko admitted to Maj. Weaver that he was the one who was talking on the CB. He stated that he said "someone needs to go help Dep. Toole before he gets his ass kicked". (Dep. Charles Toole was on a call at another location and was having a problem and had called for back up). Dep. Danko's actions were inappropriate and unprofessional.
