Upon review of all of the available body worn cameras, it was determined that Inv. Christopher Brown had taken Mr. Mathis's firearm permit. Inv. Brown stated to me that he gave it to Richard Russell at the end of the investigation. Upon speaking to Russell, he stated that he did receive the permit from Inv. Brown but doesn't remember what he did with it. I contacted the Richmond County Probate Court Clerk in an attempt to see about getting Mr. Mathis a replacement permit, but was told that since Mr. Mathis paid the citation for Engaging in Drug Activity on April 22, 2021, receipt number 175588, he would not be eligible for a replacement for the next 5 years. I contacted Mr. Mathis and relayed this information to him. Mr. Mathis stated that he understood.

Mason wanted to file a complaint on Inv. Richard Russell for confiscating his firearm for no reason. Mason stated he was exited the parking lot of a club in his vehicle onto Central Ave and stopped to talk to some girls yelling at him. Mason continued driving and was smoking a vape when he was pulled over by Inv. Russell who stated he saw him smoking weed and also smelled weed coming from the car. Inv. Russell then asked to search his vehicle and Mason granted permission. Inv. Russell located his firearm and asked why he did not tell him about the firearm, and then confiscated it for no reason. Inv. Russell also told Mason to "shut up" about firearm questions or he would go to Mason's residence and confiscate the rest of his firearms. Sgt. Lee located the actual Case #: 21-148826. Mason stated it was 21-148886 or 21-148186.
