Brown but doesn't remember what he did with it. I contacted the Richmond County Probate Court Clerk in an attempt to see about getting Mr. Mathis a replacement permit, but was told that since Mr. Mathis paid the citation for Engaging in Drug Activity on April 22, 2021, receipt number 175588, he would not be eligible for a replacement for the next 5 years. I contacted Mr. Mathis and relayed this information to him. Mr. Mathis stated that he understood.

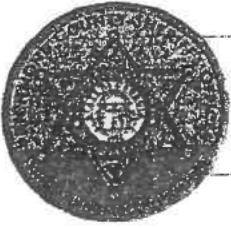

Russell pulled her over and asked for her Driver's license when she questioned him why she was being pulled over even though she knew she was speeding, but she had already slowed down well before Dep. Russell pulled her over. Clayton stated Dep. Russell told her the reason and "snatched the hell out of her license" from her hand. Clayton stated this made her mad so she cursed at him. Clayton stated Dep. Russell then asked if the car was stolen which made her even more mad because she felt like she was being stereotyped and she cursed him out again. Clayton stated Dep. Russell asked her who the car belonged to and she said her cousin and Dep. Russell replied if he runs the car and it doesn't come back to her cousin, he is going to snatch her out of the car. Clayton stated Dep. Russell then threatened to take her to jail after she refused to sign the citation, then wouldn't let her sign it using his hand to block it and not bringing it close enough to her car. Clayton stated she felt Dep. Russell was antagonizing her the entire time.
