CONSENT ORDER

By agreement of the Georgia Peace Officer Standards and Training Council and Richard A. Russell, Respondent, the following disposition of this matter is entered pursuant to the provisions of the Georgia Administrative Procedure Act, codified as O.C.G.A. § 50-13-13(a)(4).

FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The parties agree to waive any and all Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

ORDER

The Georgia Peace Officer Standards and Training Council hereby Orders, and Respondent hereby agrees, to the following terms:

1.

The <u>Denial</u> of the Respondent's Application for Certification to be a Jailer in the State of Georgia is <u>withheld</u>. Respondent's Application for Certification is hereby approved and Respondent is eligible to attend basic mandate provided that all Certifications retained and / or

obtained by the Respondent shall be place on probation for a period of twenty-four (24) months probation to begin upon payment of applicable probation supervision and monitoring costs (\$ 120.00 per year), a total \$240.00. Additional conditions are as follows: Respondent shall complete an Ethics and Professionalism course at his own expense and submit proof of completion to GA POST Council within first six months of his probationary period.

2.

During the period of Probation, Respondent shall not violate any law of this State or of the United States, or any rule or policy of the Georgia Peace Officer Standards and Training Council, nor any rule or regulation of the Respondent's employing agency. Should Respondent be arrested for any criminal offense during the period of Probation, Respondent's certification shall be immediately suspended pending disposition of the criminal case.

3.

Respondent acknowledges that he/she has read this Consent Order, and understands the terms and conditions described herein. Respondent further understands that he/she has the right to a hearing in this matter, and waives such right by freely, voluntarily, and knowingly entering into this Consent Order.

As evidenced by his/her signature affixed below, Respondent agrees to abide by all laws of the State of Georgia, the rules and regulations of the Georgia Peace Officer Standards and Training Council, and the provisions of this Consent Order.

Respondent's probation may be vacated, and his/her certification(s) may be further sanctioned, up to and including revocation in accordance with the Georgia

Administrative Procedure Act, upon violation of any term and condition of this Consent Order.

- 1. RR is a candidate (Jailer).
- 2. Candidate RR has been employed with the most recent law enforcement unit since 07/05/2015.
- 3. Candidate RR is currently employed by a law enforcement unit.
- 4. Candidate RR was issued a pre-service authorization on 07/16/2010.
- 5. Candidate RR did not report his 08/23/2012 arrest until three years after the date of the arrest.
- 6. Candidate RR did not submit a notarized response to this investigation.

CASE SUMMARY

On or about 07/10/2012, Candidate RR was served with a "Good Behavior" order stating he was not to have any contact with WH.

On or about 08/23/2012, Candidate RR was arrested for Aggravated Stalking(f) and Unlawful Conduct During a 911 Call after an investigation revealed Candidate RR called local law enforcement complaining WH was having a loud party. Local officers responded to WH's home and determined there was not a loud party at her house. The investigation also determined Candidate RR was reporting the noise violations while he was in another state.

On or about 03/15/2013, the charges were "dead docketed."

On or about 07/07/14, the charges were removed from "dead docket" and "nolle prossed."
