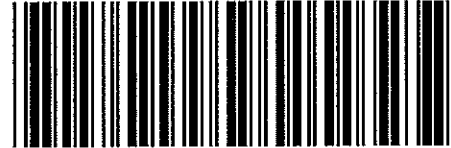

PROBABLE CAUSE COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION TO COUNCIL

CASE NO. 006-341-07-12

1. Said individual is Multi-Certified (Juvenile Correctional Officer 01/25/99; Basic 10/15/99; LIDAR Operator 06/13/11; Radar Operator 06/13/11; Field Training Officer 01/09/12).
2. Said officer was employed with the most recent law enforcement unit on 09/12/06.
3. Said officer is currently employed by a law enforcement unit.

CASE SUMMARY

On or about 07/12/12, local law enforcement responded to the officer's residence regarding a domestic disturbance call. According to reports, the officer appeared to be under the influence of "multiple alcoholic beverages." While responding officers were questioning witnesses, the officer became "irate telling officers nothing happened" and instructed witnesses to go back into the house. The officer told witnesses to "no longer speak to officers." Reports show the officer told witnesses several times to "shut the fuck up and go in the house!," while they were speaking to responding officers. The officer was told the "antics would no longer be tolerated" and that he/she was under arrest. The officer took "an aggressive posture, clenching [his/her] fists" and charged at Sgt C. Officer A drew an expandable baton and the officer stopped and was placed into handcuffs. The officer was arrested and charged with Disorderly Conduct and Obstruction. The Agency reported this arrest to POST Council. Agency documentation shows the officer was "highly intoxicated" and that he/she "does not remember [his/her] actions due to alcohol blackout."

On or about 10/22/12, the officer plead Nolo Contendere to Disorderly Conduct and Obstruction was Nolle Prossed. The officer was sentenced to a \$200 fine.

As of 01/14/13, the officer is still employed with the same law enforcement agency as a police officer.

DISCIPLINARY HISTORY

1. On or about 02/02/04, the officer received a Letter of Reprimand for Incompetent, Negligent, or Inefficient performance in the duties of the position held.
2. On or about 03/08/04, the officer resigned from a previous agency before discipline was recommended and imposed for Failure to Obey a Direct Order.
