Incident Summary

Officer Batson observed a vehicle speeding, and initiated a traffic stop on I-264W near the 16mm. On contact, Officer Batson detected the odor of alcoholic beverage coming from the operator. When asked, the operator stated he'd consumed one beer at Texas Roadhouse. When Batson re-approached the vehicle on the passenger side, he observed an empty alcohol bottle under the driver's seat Officer Batson asked the operator to exit the vehicle, and then performed SFST's. Officer Batson requested the operator to provide a breath (PBT) sample, to which the operator gave numerous evasive answers, and started questioning Officer Batson

Officer Batson instructed the operator to turn around and place his hands behind his back while grabbing the operator's right wrist. Operator then attempted to turn to the right and face Officer Batson, Officer responded by attempting to push the operator against the front passenger of his police vehicle to gain control. The operator pushed away from the vehicle with his left hand in another attempt to face the Officer Officer Batson preformed a leg sweep in order to gain control of the resisting Subject. This caused both of them to fall backwards onto the grass next to the shoulder (there were large rocks in the grass in that location.). Officer Batson landed on top of the operator face to face Officer Batson's right hand can to rest on the operator's collarbone/throat area and held that position only long enough to call for backup on the radio and then immediately released the hold. Officer Batson gave verbal commands to the operator to get on the ground, roll over to his stomach and give up his hands. Officer Batson stated clearly to the operator that he was under arrest. The operator continued to struggle and attempt to roll and push himself up from the ground while Officer Batson was on his back. Officer Batson utilized an empty hand strike to the Operator's upper torso/head in an attempt to keep him on the ground. Officer Batson still could not gain control of the

struggling operator, until VIU 12 who was passing by, stopped to assist, removed handcuffs from Batson's belt, and placed a cuff onto the operator's right wrist. Officer Batson was able to cuff the left wrist. The operator still continued to struggle and attempted to bridge himself up from the ground. Officer Batson remained in a position of advantage holding the operator against the ground until other units arrived on scene.

The operator sustained abrasions to his face, while Officer Batson's pants leg was torn. Louisville Metro EMS 244A (run # E19035382) responded to the scene. The operator refused transport to a hospital.





I concur with Sergeant Keller's assessment. It is important that any sign of physical aggression or resistance by a person be dealt with immediately. This is particularly crucial when dealing with such resistance on the shoulder of an interstate. Any hesitation to do so could result in in the officer and citizen crossing into the traveled portion of the roadway, resulting in death or critical injuries by passing vehicles. Immediately taking Mr. Miller to the ground was appropriate action by Officer Batson. The wearable video clearly shows Mr. Miller was physically resistant to arrest and Officer Batson's actions were necessary and appropriate. Officer Batson followed policies and procedures as well as clearly established law. No Action Recommended.
