Lt. Green,

On April 14, 2019 at 2344 HRS Cpl. Ronnie Wyatt was dispatched to 5185 Old National HWY, College Park, GA 30349 in reference to a motor vehicle accident. At this point neither you or I were assigned to Grey Nights. Per my research the accident involved a gray Chevrolet Equinox and a white Ford Transit Van. Based on the event history the equinox went through a GCIC query but the transit van did not. Cpl. Wyatt requested South dispatch for an accident case number and was issued case number 2019-004871.

On April 15, 2019 at 1315 HRS Cpl. Marilyn White was dispatched to a motor vehicle accident and was issued case number 2019-004901. Due to Cpl. Wyatt not completing his accident report prior to him leaving shift, Cpl. White was able to use his case number.

On April 30, 2019 Cpl. Wyatt was called in for Military duty and the orders advised he would return to work on May 27, 2019. Cpl. Wyatt returned to work on June 3, 2019 and was then pulled into the office to complete all missing reports. When Cpl. Wyatt advised me that he was finished with all outstanding reports I inquired about accident report 2019-004871. Cpl. Wyatt advised me he was missing Mr. Newberry's vehicle information and that he attempted multiple times to call Mr. Newberry but he did not answer. Cpl. Wyatt stated that he emailed Mr. Newberry advising him the issue and to please send him the vehicle information.

On June 12, 2019 I asked Cpl. Wyatt did he get the vehicle information from Mr. Newberry and he advised he did and that he would complete the report. On June 23, 2019 I checked to see if Cpl. Wyatt completed the report and realized that the case number was used by Cpl. White. I then instructed Cpl. Wyatt to come to the precinct and instructed him to complete the report under case number 2019-004901 prior to him leaving shift. At that time I realized that Cpl. Wyatt did not complete the report at all due to viewing him entering vehicle information and driver information. At 0746 HRS Cpl. Wyatt called me and advised he completed the report. I then went into the traffic report section and I viewed the report in there. At 0842 HRS I received a phone call from Greg Newberry JR. who advised he was at the Old National precinct attempting to pick up the accident report. Mr. Newberry stated that he had case number 2019-004901 but he was not listed in the report nor was the vehicle he was driving. Mr. Newberry stated that he was driving a white Ford Transit Van and the other driver was in a Gray Chevrolet Equinox.

I then called Grays Towing and asked what vehicle did they tow on the incident time and date. Grays personnel advised they had a white 2019 Ford Transit Van Temporary GA: TAG:

24242946 VIN: 1FTYR2CM2KKA13973. I ran the vehicle through GCIC and the vehicle came back stolen out of Union City PD. The report date for Union City was January 22, 2019. I then notified East Point police and they responded to Grays Towing and removed the vehicle from GCIC.

After viewing the Utility Body Worn footage of the scene it appeared that it was a three vehicle accident. It also appeared that Cpl. Blalock wrote down all of the information from the accident and gave the piece of paper he wrote the information down on to Cpl. Wyatt.

Based on my investigation Cpl. Ronnie Wyatt committed the following infractions from the South Fulton General Orders:

*Code of Conduct Canons

Canon 3: Insubordination

Canon 3: INSUBORDINATION

Failure or deliberate refusal of any employee to obey a lawful order given by a superior officer or an employee acting in a supervisory capacity shall be insubordination. Ridiculing a superior officer/supervisor or their orders, whether in or out of their presence, is also insubordination. Employees will promptly obey all proper and lawful orders and will not be discourteous, abusive, disloyal, profane, bitter or threatening to any higher authority.

Preliminary Investigations

PRELIMINARY INVESTIGATIONS (SC 5.19) 17

The Patrol Division is responsible for conducting preliminary investigations of all incidents and categories of crime. Procedures are established to aid in conducting a preliminary investigation:

Upon arrival at a scene, the officer shall observe all the conditions, events, and remarks, to include

- Provide aid to the injured
- Determining if an offense has actually been committed and if so, the exact nature of the offense
- Locate and identify witnesses, if applicable
- Full name, telephone number, and address
- Maintain the crime scene and protect evidence
- Interview the complainant, victim, and witnesses when available
- Obtain description of suspects (name, address, physical description)
- Determine what information witnesses, victim, or complainant knows
- Furnish other field units through radio the descriptions, method, and direction of flight and other relevant information concerning wanted person or vehicles
- Arrange for the collection of evidence
- Notify investigators and / or identification section (if necessary) to collect evidence and photograph the scene

Due to the multiple infractions with the South Fulton General Orders and Police and Procedures I recommend this case be turned over to Internal Affairs.

On 07/02/2019 I was able to assign the correct case numbers to each case with permission from Lt. W. Orgertrice.

Attached is memorandum's from Cpl. R. Wyatt and Cpl. C. Blalock, Cpl. Wyatt's original accident report (with false information), the police report from Union city, police report from East Point Police, the series of emails from front desk staff, Cpl. Wyatt's military orders, an email from Greg Newberry to Cpl. Wyatt, and the GCIC stolen vehicle notification.

I am currently attempting to make the appropriate corrections to the report with Cpl. R. Wyatt.



Upon arrival, MCCOURT met with the complainant later identified as BRIAN LAMB an employee of Auto Nation Ford. LAMB stated a black female later identified as AMANDA SERDA purchased two Ford Transit vans from the dealership on 01-22-2019 using the name ELIZABETH HUBER. LAMB stated he then received a call from HUBER stating that she did not purchase any vehicles from Ford and has never been in Georgia before. LAMB stated SERDA fraudulently purchased one 2019 Ford Transit Van VIN 1FTYR2CM0KKA04253 valued at \$47549.41 and one 2019 Ford Transit Van VIN 1FTYR2CM2KKA13973 valued at \$47144.62. LAMB stated on today's date he was able to get SERDA to come back to the dealership to purchase an additional vehicle. LAMB stated once SERDA arrived at the dealership he contacted the Police. MCCOURT then met with SERDA and requested her information. She provided MCCOURT with her proper information.

MCCOURT then placed SERDA in double locked handcuffs and secured her in the rear of Union City Patrol Vehicle marked 9777. MCCOURT then had LAMB complete a written statement form for the incident. MCCOURT then transported SERDA to the Union City Police Department. Upon Arrival, MCCOURT and SERDA met with DETECTIVE WEST of the same department. WEST then interviewed SERDA, but she requested to speak with an attorney. SERDA did spontaneously utter that she could get the vans back. MCCOURT then completed his paperwork and secured warrants for the arrest of SERDA. Once complied MCCOURT then transported SERDA to the South Fulton Municipal Regional Jail. Upon arrival, SERDA was released to jail staff on two Charged of Identity Fraud a violation of O.C.G.A. 16-9-121, two charges of Forgery in the first degree a violation of 16-9-1 and Theft by Taking a violation of O.C.G.A. 16-8-2. LAMB stated on today's date he was able to get SERDA to come back to the dealership to purchase an additional vehicle. LAMB stated once SERDA arrived at the dealership he contacted the Police. MCCOURT then met with SERDA and requested her information. She provided MCCOURT with her proper information.

MCCOURT then placed SERDA in double locked handcuffs and secured her in the rear of Union City Patrol Vehicle marked 9777. MCCOURT then had LAMB complete a written statement form for the incident. MCCOURT then transported SERDA to the Union City Police Department. Upon Arrival, MCCOURT and SERDA met with DETECTIVE WEST of the same department. WEST then interviewed SERDA, but she requested to speak with an attorney. SERDA did spontaneously utter that she could get the vans back. MCCOURT then completed his paperwork and secured warrants for the arrest of SERDA. Once complied MCCOURT then transported SERDA to the South Fulton Municipal Regional Jail. Upon arrival, SERDA was released to jail staff on two Charged of Identity Fraud a violation of O.C.G.A. 16-9-121, two charges of Forgery in the first degree a violation of 16-9-1 and Theft by Taking a violation of O.C.G.A. 16-8-2. The white in color 2019 Ford Transit Van bearing Georgia temporary tag 1119214977 VIN 1FTYR2CM0KKA04253 and 2019 white in color Ford Transit Van bearing Georgia temporary tag 1119214977 VIN 1FTYR2CM2KKA13973 were placed onto G.C.I.C. as stolen.
