During your interaction with the residents the juvenile resident advised you that he wanted to fight you. The juvenile then descended a flight of stairs and approached you. The incident led to the juvenile being taken to the ground and charged with simple assault. The policy states that cameras should be active during calls for service and when deputies deem appropriate.

Based on your experience and the history of interaction with both the juvenile and his mother you knew or should have known that your camera should have been on at the time of the altercation, as you had sufficient time to activate it had you been wearing it while the juvenile descended the steps to your location.

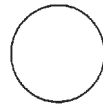
Vehicle # 1 was exiting the parking lot of O'Reilly Part. Vehicle # 2 was traveling north on Peach Orchard Road.

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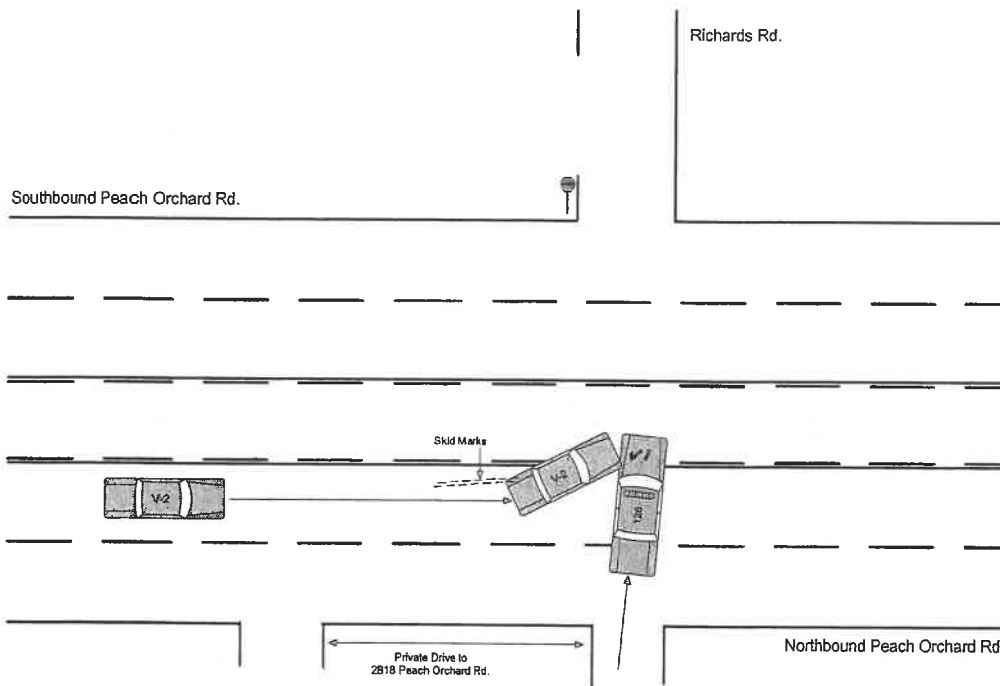
