Kiana Hollins stated on 03/20/23 she was pulled over on Olive Rd. by Deputy Terry Parks, see case #23-059700. Hollins stated she was told her license was suspended and she was detained. Hollins stated it was later learned that her old CDL license was suspended, but her new Class C license was valid. Hollins stated there was a lot of back and forth between herself and Deputy Parks. Hollins stated she was released, and as she walked away Deputy Parks stated "goodnight bitch". Hollins stated Deputy Parks was very rude and unprofessional.

Deferred to Supervisor

Supervisor/Investigative Comments.
Lt Kenneth Daniels reviewed Deputies BWC. Lt. Daniels noted that Hollins was belligerent towards Dep. Parks, Dep. Santiago, and Sgt. Trimmingham. Lt. Daniels observed the "back and Forth" indicated by Hollins in her complaint and noted that the Deputies remained professional in their responses and provided explanations for their actions along with information as requested by Hollins. Lt. Daniels noted that as Dep. Parks was providing Hollins with information to file an IA complaint, his BWC began to alert for low battery life and ultimately shut off. There was no evidence substantiating Hollins claims about Deputy unprofessionalism. Lt. Daniels spoke with Hollins on 040523 and advised her the incident would be documented. Lt. Daniels reviewed the BWC with Dep. Parks for educational purposes. NO further actions were taken.
