Deputy Wilson advised in reference to 22-176180 that both parties had already exchanged information and the driver of vehicle # 1 was leaving the scene so he didn't complete a report. In reference to 22-160331 Deputy Wilson advised he was unable to determine where the accident occurred, so no report was completed. In both incidents, Sgt. Nguyen advised Deputy Wilson to complete an accident report. On October 10, 2022, I contacted Deputy Wilson about the reports not being completed. Deputy Wilson advised he will complete the reports on this date. On October 17, 2022, reports still had not been completed and Deputy Wilson advised he had forgotten to complete them. Deputy Wilson has been warned in the past and was suspended on June 27 for 1 Day for Failure to do a Report.

Deputy Robert Wilson failed to activate his BWC during this call. Deputy Wilson violated policy by failing to do so. This is Deputy Wilson's 1st violation of the BWC policy.

Deputy Wilson advised that he understands that his actions were not appropriate, and that he most remain professional at all times. He stated that this would not occur again.
