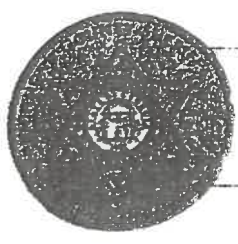

On November 28, 2022 at 1000 hrs, Sgt. Lee spoke with Saliard in IA via phone who wished to file a complaint. Saliard stated on November 24, 2022 at approximately 0100hrs, she observed four to five cop cars around her house. Saliard stated Deputies were knocking on her door and one stated they had an arrest warrant for her arrest. Saliard stated she didn't open her door and called 911 instead. Saliard stated she just moved to Augusta and didn't have a warrant but opened the door when the dispatcher told her to open the door. Saliard stated when she opened the door, a Deputy grabbed her and "put on ground hard" which was concrete and then handcuffed her. The Deputy then got her ID and another Deputy said "that is not her" and Cpl Dailey began apologizing for the confusion. Saliard stated she was given a citation for Excessive Noise for her loud music. Saliard stated she had dental work done approximately 2 months ago and all of teeth that had crowns were damaged and she only has four teeth. Saliard stated she also remembered getting hit in the head. Saliard stated 4-5 Deputies for loud music and excessive force used is ridiculous. She wants her teeth fixed as well.

Supervisor/Investigative Comments.

Citation Given - 299492. BWC Vids reviewed, could hear loud music past 1 A.M. Deputies knocked on door numerous times, advised who they were, why they were there, but Saliard refused to open the door until 20 minutes later. Citation was explained, politely, professionally. Not one Deputy touched Saliard.
