On 07/28/14 around 0850 hours, I was working in the APD evidence room when I was informed of an Officer Involved shooting which had taken place in Antioch. I was informed by Sergeant Fuhrmann that this case would be investigated as a County Protocol case in which the Antioch Police Department, Contra Costa County District Attorney's Office, and the Contra Costa Crime Lab will all be assisting with this investigation.

Corporal Pfeiffer and myself along with several APD detectives headed out to the scene around 0915 hours. The shooting occurred at 4157 Folsom drive which is a two story residence. Upon arrival, I noticed the scene was secured by APD patrol officers which had been blocked off with yellow caution tape. I met with Officer McDonald who currently in charge of the crime scene log. There were two vehicles parked on the south side of the driveway and the garage door was open. I noticed several items of bloody clothing was lying on the ground in the driveway and had been marked by patrol with yellow placard numbers. There was also a smear of apparent blood leading from the rear of the garage out to the driveway. There was a white SUV vehicle with California plate [REDACTED] inside of the garage that had the back hatch open. I noticed a couple spent shell casings underneath the white SUV which had been marked with yellow placard numbers as well. I took a few overall photographs of the scene to document its current condition.

We headed back to APD and a briefing was conducted with APD detectives and agents of the Contra Costa County DA's office. Detective Vanderpool was assigned as the primary detective in this case, and I was paired with Jimenez and Tuscher from the Contra Costa County crime lab to process the scene.

Around 1430 hours, I met with Jimenez and Tuscher at APD after they had collected evidence from Officer Ward. Jimenez, Tuscher, and myself headed out to the scene at 4517 Folsom drive around 1500 hours. After Jimenez and Tuscher had taken their overall photographs and measurements, I took a few more detailed photographs of the spent casings and projectiles located underneath the placard numbers before

Jimenez and Tuscher collected those items as evidence.

After being notified that the warrant had been signed, Tuscher and I then took overall photographs of the white SUV, CA# [REDACTED]. Around 1700 hours, APD detectives and the DA's office investigators arrived on scene to conduct a search of the residence and garage. Corporal Pfeiffer took photographs inside of the residence during the search while I stayed outside in the garage while it was searched.

After the vehicle was searched, I was instructed to collect the following items of evidence:

E#1: California DMV issued Identification card to Timothy Randolph; located inside of console.

E#2: 1 Contra Costa County Medi-Cal Expansion Program card, 1 State of California benefits identification card, 2 East County adult mental health services appointment cards scheduled for 06/24/14 and 09/09/14, and 1 East County adult mental health prescription dated 07/15/14 all issued to Timothy Randolph; located inside of console.

E#3: Motorola Pagenet pager, black, serial A0528793 located on the right side of vehicle Ca# [REDACTED] on the ground inside the garage.

E#4: Samsung cell phone, black, model SCH-R360, serial number 26835460112286656 located on top of console.

After the search of the residence and garage had been completed, I headed back to APD around 1818 hours. All the above listed items of evidence that I had collected were later logged into APD evidence as well as the photographs, **E#5**.

I have nothing further.

NARRATIVE

On 07/28/2014 I was working in the Investigations Bureau when overheard this call transpire over the Police radio. I heard an Officer advise that there was shots fired. It was later confirmed through dispatch that an APD Officer shot at suspect at 4157 Folsom Dr.

I looked at the unit monitor through my computer and read that Officer Ward and Officer McDonald were dispatched to a detail regarding a found rifle. There was a synopsis posted in the detail that read as follows: *Per Cpl. Fortner do an area check in the area for a white Chevy Tahoe. Lic# [REDACTED] Resp Timothy Randolph lives somewhere on Folsom and is a PC 246 responsible involving some type of rifle.*

I remained at APD to await a briefing and to create investigative plan on how the investigation would proceed with the given information. The Contra Costa County District Attorney's Office was notified of this investigation and responded to APD to conduct a parallel investigation (Protocol). I was assigned as the lead APD investigator for this case. A briefing was held at APD and I learned the following information:

Officer Ward was dispatched to [REDACTED] to pick up a rifle that was located in the street by Wit [REDACTED]. It was later discovered that Wit [REDACTED] located the rifle in the street in front of 4157 Folsom Dr about 20 feet from the bottom of the driveway. While Officer Ward was in route to the location, Cpl. Fortner informed dispatch that he wanted two units to respond to the area because there was a subject in the area (Timothy Randolph) who was wanted in relation to a PC 246. The PC 246 case indicated there was a rifle used as the weapon.

As Officer Ward was arriving on scene, he located Res-Randolph's vehicle in the area. Officer Ward pulled behind Res-Randolph's vehicle and attempted to initiate a traffic enforcement stop. Res-Randolph failed to yield to Officer Ward and continued to drive toward his home. Officer Ward exited his vehicle as Res-Randolph pulled into the driveway and engaged Res-Randolph. Res-Randolph refused to comply with Officer Ward's commands and drove into his garage. When Res-Randolph exited the vehicle, Officer Ward noticed that Res-Randolph hands were concealed in his waist band. Res-Randolph refused to expose his

hands after several verbal commands by Officer Ward. Based off Res-Randolph furtive movements, hands concealed in waist band, failure to comply with verbal commands and Officer Ward's knowledge of Res-Randolph possessing a firearm from a prior case, Officer Ward feared for his life, had reason to believe that Res-Randolph was armed. Officer Ward fired several shots at Res-Randolph to stop his threat.

At the conclusion of the briefing, APD and DA investigators were assigned to teams and given assignments to complete. The teams and assignments are summarized below:

1-Det. Vanderpool (APD), Det. Meads (APD) were assigned with Senior inspector Hendershot (CCCD). Assigned to interview Officer Ward, Officer McDonald, Wit- [REDACTED] and Wit- [REDACTED].

2- Det. Stenger (APD) assigned with Senior inspector Ike Menchaca (CCCD). Assigned to author search warrant for residence, vehicles, phones and DNA

3-Det. Joannides (APD) assigned with Senior inspector Ahern (CCCD). Assigned to interview on scene residents of 4157 Folsom Dr. ([REDACTED]) and [REDACTED]

4-Det. Mcmanus (APD) assigned with Senior inspector Darryl Holcombe. Assigned to to contact Con-Fire and AMR. Locate and interview Res Randolph's mother ([REDACTED]).

5- Det. Hewitt (APD) and Det Koch(APD) were assigned to locate any possible surveillance video, 911 calls and Police radio traffic.

6- Det. Colley (APD) assigned with Senior inspector Coffey (CCCD). Assigned to conduct and area canvas to try and locate any potential witnesses.

See APD detective reports and Contra Costa County DA investigator reports for details in regards to their assignments. I was involved in the interviews with Wit- [REDACTED] Wit- [REDACTED] Officer McDonald and Officer Ward. Inspector Hendershot documented Wit- [REDACTED] and Wit- [REDACTED] statements. Det. Meads documented Officer McDonald's statement. I documented Officer Ward's statement. Officer Ward's statement was recorded and transcribed. See attached recording for exact wording. Officer Ward told me the following in summary:

He has been a sworn Police Officer with Antioch PD for 9 years. He has been assigned to the patrol division and has been there throughout the duration of his career with APD. He is also a member of a county team (MAMFF). MAMFF is a team that includes multiple agencies in the county that specialize in riots and crowd control type situations. He is also a current member of the Nation Guard. He is currently working every Sunday, Monday Tuesday's and every other Saturday 0700 to 1900 hours. (Red day shift)

The uniform put on prior to his shift consisted of dark blue colored BDU style pants with a matching short sleeve shirt with a ballistic vest underneath. City of Antioch Police patches are attached to both shoulders

with the name (N Ward) embroidered on the right side of his shirt near the chest. An embroidered city of Antioch Police badge over the left side of his chest. His duty belt consisted of his duty weapon (226 Sig Sauer 40 cal), department issued tazer on left thigh, Police radio, baton, ammunition magazine pouch with two loaded magazines (12 round) and a single hand cuff case with two sets of handcuffs inside.

Prior to his shift he selected vehicle number 1233 for the day. He conducted a pre vehicle inspection. At the time of the inspection, the forward red and blue lights were visible with a solid red light. The vehicle siren also functioned properly.

When he started his shift the first call he remembers going to was an audible alarm call. After the audible he drove downtown to conduct some follow-up in regards to a CFS referral. While on the the CFS follow-up, he was asked to clear for a found property call. The call consisted of a person that located a rifle in the area of Folsom Dr. He looked on his GPS to confirm the area of where he was dispatched to. While he was driving to the location, Cpl Fortner updated the call requesting two Officers respond to the detail. Shortly after that update, Cpl. Fortner provided them with some more information that there was a subject who lived in the area who drove a white SUV who was wanted for a possible shooting. After those updates, he recalled going to an address on Folsom (first house on the left) just a week prior. He remembers looking for a male who was driving an SUV who was involved in the shooting. He did have a license plate number for the vehicle and the suspects name inside of his vehicle. (He was unable to recall from memory the suspects name or license plate) He assumed that Cpl. Fortner had two units respond to the location based off the fact the rifle was located in the area of a suspects home.

When he arrived in the area he was making a left hand turn onto Wildhorse from Hillcrest Ave. He stopped on Wildhorse Dr at Folsom waiting for traffic to go by so he could turn left onto Folsom Dr. He spotted a white colored SUV occupied by a black male adult driver (Solo occupant). The SUV was on Folsom getting ready to make a right hand turn onto Wildhorse. From where he was stopped he was able to match the last three numbers of the license plate to the photo he had of the suspect vehicle. After he realized it was the suspect vehicle, he advised dispatch that he had priority radio traffic because he was behind the suspect vehicle. (He believed that he was behind the vehicle that was suspect in a shooting) The vehicle proceeded to the intersection of Wildhorse Dr at Hillcrest Ave. He noticed that Officer McDonald was in the area (VIA GPS) and wanted to wait for cover before he made an enforcement stop on the vehicle. When the traffic light cycled from red to green, the SUV made a u-turn and began to drive back towards the house in question. He provided dispatch the direction of travel and mentioned that he believed the vehicle was headed back to his house. He decided to attempt an enforcement stop because he did not want the vehicle to go back to his house. He could hear his siren and see the reflection of his lights coming from the patrol vehicle. The SUV made a left hand turn from Wildhorse back onto Folsom Dr. He estimated the vehicle to be travelling at 25 to 30 mph. The vehicle made no effort to pull over. He was watching the driver in the vehicle and he could see his hand waving in front of the rear view mirror. It looked as if the driver had something in his hand. Even though the rear window was tinted, the front window was providing enough light to where he could see an object in his hand. He may have mentioned to dispatch that he could see something in his hand while pursuing the vehicle. (Ward described the object in his hand to be approximately 4inch by 3 inch in size) He believed it was possibly a small handgun.

The vehicle proceeded to his house on Folsom Dr and stopped partially in the street in front of his driveway. He felt as if the subject may run or exit his vehicle and start shooting at him. He felt he was in a position of dis-advantage so he exited his vehicle and gave commands for the the suspect to turn his vehicle off and to exit the vehicle. He parked his vehicle to the far left side of the street (Folsom Dr) just prior to the house. As he exited his vehicle, the vehicle began to pull into the driveway and into an open garage. He drew his firearm as he approached the vehicle. He gave several commands for the suspect to turn the vehicle off and to exit the vehicle. He believes that vehicle was put in park because he did see the reverse lights flash on and off really quick. When he approached to the rear of the vehicle on the drivers side, the driver attempted to shut the garage door. This concerned him because he didn't know if the suspect was trying to trap him in the garage and he was concerned there may be another person inside the garage or house. The door would not shut because his feet were in the way of the garage door sensors. He began to shout commands at the driver, "get out of the car, show me your hands, turn off your engine." He thought maybe the suspect was going to stay inside of his vehicle. He was trying to wait for K9 Officer McDonald to arrive to engage the suspect. He may have re-holstered his weapon so he could use his baton to hit the back window to get the suspects attention. He possibly even used his firearm to tap on the window. He was yelling for the suspect to exit the vehicle. At that time the suspect rapidly exited the vehicle through the drivers side door. He exited the vehicle in a manner to where he thought the male was either going to run or fight. When the male exited the vehicle, he had his hands either in his pockets or in his waist band. The suspect was facing him at the time but could not see his hands. In an angry sounding voice, the male said, "Fuck you!" "I'm going in my house. Fuck you!" He had his gun pointed at the male and was yelling for him to get on the ground and to show his hands. The male took one step and began to turn around away from him. He still could not see the males hands but he did see his right arm moving in in an upward direction which he perceived as a drawing motion. His right arm was a "shooter triangle" position. (Hand was concealed in waist band and upper right arm was parallel with right shoulder) As his arm came up and out of his waist band, he could see something black in color in his hand. He could not tell what the object was but he believed it was a gun based off the way the male was holding the object. He could see the males thumb and fingers wrapped around the object. Based off the fact that the male was wanted for a prior shooting, the male ignored commands from a Police Officer that had a weapon pointed at him, being involved in a pursuit and was being hostile yelling "Fuck you", he believed that the male was an armed and dangerous person. As the male was turning back towards him, he believed that the male was armed and was going to shoot him. He discharged two to three shots at the male.

After he shot the male, the male went down to one knee and it looked as if he was still trying to draw a weapon from his waist band or pocket. The male looked at him and said, "You shot me you mother fucker." He told the male to get on the ground but the male tried to stand back up as he continued making the drawing motion. He fired two more shots at the male. He believes one of the rounds missed because he could see a dent in the refrigerator just behind the male. The male proceeded to pull a bed box spring mattress over himself. The male was almost completely concealed underneath the box spring but he could see movement. At that time Officer McDonald arrived on scene. Officer McDonald and himself were both yelling for the male to show his hands. The male stayed underneath the box spring. When Officer Bedgood arrived, they pulled the box spring off of the male. Officer McDonald was asking where the gun was. The male told them that there was a gun inside the car. They told the male to show his hands and it looked as if he was trying to stand up. When more Officers arrived, they were able to hand cuff the male. While hand cuffing, someone from the residence opened the door and asked what was going on. They told the resident to shut the door.

Once they had control of the scene, Officers cleared the vehicle, garage and house.

Officer Ward informed me that the last time he shot his firearm was approximately 6 months ago at APD. He estimated he has shot his duty weapon six to seven different times within the last year. He has carried the same duty weapon since his employment began with APD. The only type of firearms training he received was from the Police academy and in house training at APD. His military firearm training mainly consisted of rifle training.

Officer Ward informed me that he had personal knowledge about the PC 246 case Res-Randolph was suspect in. He was given details by Officer Matis that Res-Randolph shot at another vehicle using a rifle from his vehicle.

Officer Ward also informed me that he was concerned about how Res-Randolph drove so calm while he was behind him with his lights and sirens activated. He recalls watching an incident involving Police where an Officer was behind a suspect vehicle with his lights and sirens activated where the suspect drove calm. When the suspect vehicle decided to stop, the suspect exited his vehicle and shot at the Officer. He felt by the actions of Res-Randolph that he was going to be shot when Res-Randolph decided to stop.

That concluded Officer Wards's statement. See attached recording for exact wording. (Transcripts will also later be attached to this case)

Officer Ward's attorney (Julia Fox) was present during the interview.

On 7/29/2014, I responded to John Muir Medical Hospital with Det. Stenger and Senior inspector Hendershot to speak with Res-Randolph. Prior to speaking with Res-Randolph, I read Res-Randolph his Miranda rights from a county issued Miranda card. Res-Randolph stated he understood his rights and chose to speak with me. Res-Randolph told me the following in summary:

When he was driving his vehicle in the area of his residence he did see a Police vehicle behind him. He could hear the Police vehicle lights and sirens behind him. He did not want to pull over because he did not want to catch a new case for having a gun inside of his vehicle. (Res-Randolph later told me that during this interview that he had a rifle in the back of his vehicle) He decided to drive back to his house and drove into the garage. He did exit the vehicle with his hands up when he was shot and he did not have anything in his hands. He did hear the Officer give him commands to put his hands up and to get in the ground. He did tell the Officer to fuck off and that he was going to go inside his house.

Randolph stated he wishes he would have just pulled over. He thought he was going to be pulled over and questioned about when he was shot at in the Kaiser parking lot a few weeks prior.

Randolph stated he does carry the sawed-off .22 rifle for protection and he did have it inside of his vehicle. He also had some .22 rounds inside of the vehicle for that rifle.

Det. Stenger showed Res-Randolph a photo of the rifle and did not tell him it was found in the street. Res-

Randolph confirmed the rifle belonged to him. Randolph informed me that the sawed-off rifle was inside his vehicle the whole time when this incident occurred. Randolph stated he bought the rifle with the stock all ready sawed-off. He last discharged the rifle on the 4th of July. He did fire the rifle in his back yard at 4157 Folsom Dr.

Res-Randolph also confirmed that the rifle located in the bedroom of his house belonged to him but the rifle does not function. He has tried to fire the rifle in the but was not able to get it to work.

The bullets in the garage do not belong to him

Res-Randolph stated that he wanted to apologize for scaring the Officer and putting him that position.

I later discovered that Res-Randolph was a convicted Felon for firearms violations along with a domestic violence conviction in 2005.

I recommend that PC29800(a)(1), PC 29805 and PC 30305 charges be filed on Arr-Randolph.

SUPPLEMENTAL REPORT

On 7-28-14 I heard officers advise over the Police radio that they located a white Chevrolet Tahoe we had been searching for. ARR/Randolph, Timothy was the responsible subject in a case last week where he had fired a weapon at another vehicle. He lives on Folsom Drive, in Antioch. I heard the officers giving their locations and heard them say they were following the vehicle on Folsom Drive. Officer Ward advised the subject was possibly driving back to his residence (4157 Folsom Drive, Antioch). Officer Ward advised the vehicle pulled into the house and they were challenging the subject. He and Officer McDonald both advised shots had been fired.

I responded Code Three to the location. When I arrived, I was asked to park my vehicle near Wildhorse Road, blocking Folsom Drive, and respond on foot to the house. When I approached the front of the home I saw ARR on the driveway, handcuffed. I covered the garage area while Cpl. Fortner covered the front door. An officer was giving instructions on the loud speaker and several residents exited the house.

Once the house and yard were clear I approached the male on the driveway. I asked him his name and he said, "Timothy Randolph." I asked him how old he is and he said, "34."

Fire and Ambulance units arrived and crews tended to ARR. They counted eight wounds (back, left side, upper, left leg, and stomach). AMR transported him to a nearby park where a medical helicopter flew him to John Muir Medical Center in Walnut Creek, CA.

Randolph did not make any statements at the scene or in the ambulance. He was wearing an oxygen mask. He was awake and alert and answering medical questions, when asked.

I responded to John Muir and met with ARR's Trauma Nurse [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated when ARR arrived at the hospital he was not conscious. ARR had been intubated by the flight crew in the air.

[REDACTED] also stated they located eight wounds and also found ARR's left femur to be broken.

They gave him two units of blood and ARR was transferred immediately to surgery. [REDACTED] was his Trauma Surgeon. ARR exited surgery at approximately 1300 hours. ARR was moved the Trauma Intensive Care Unit #2409 on the second floor.

ARR's ICU nurse ([REDACTED]) stated ARR was heavily sedated and needed another surgery. His body temperature had dropped so they brought him out to warm him. I responded to the surgery center and met with OR nurse [REDACTED]. She gave me a small, plastic jar containing gauze and a spent round.

I called for a blood tech. to respond to the hospital to collect a sample of ARR's blood. [REDACTED] At 1635 hours she drew a sample of ARR's blood.

[REDACTED] stated he removed a section of ARR's small and large intestines and said ARR suffered from internal bleeding. Dr. said the wounds are survivable. He removed the bullet from ARR's central abdomen. He added another doctor would be performing the leg surgery. The femur was badly fractured.

ARR was heavily sedated and intubated while I was with him.

Reserve Officer Thomas responded to the hospital for prisoner watch. I returned to APD and logged the bullet and the blood sample into APD Property as Evidence.

The family was placed in the investigations waiting area. After leaving the family I attended an investigations briefing, which included Inspectors from the Contra Costa DA's Office. During the briefing I was teamed with Senior Inspector Cofer. We were assigned the neighborhood surrounding 4157 Folsom Drive for a neighborhood canvass.

The following is a synopsis of persons contacted and statements taken. Refer to the name tab for further information regarding the contacted subjects:

██████████ indicated she was home and heard three to four gun shots. She immediately heard police sirens and went toward her window to see what was happening. She could not see much, but heard a male's voice saying, "Get on the floor, get your hands up."

She lives in Vallejo and does not know how to get a hold of her sister, ██████████. She recalls approximately one week ago, ██████████ told her a story about the Black male who lives across the street from their mother. ██████████ was visiting from Vallejo and parked her vehicle in front of the male's house.

██████████ told her the male pulled out a gun (unknown on description) and showed it to her. ██████████ told her the male never pointed the gun or made direct threats with it, but ██████████ related he made it known to get out from in front of his house.

This concluded ██████████ statement. I told ██████████ to have ██████████ contact me when she learns her whereabouts.

speak with them.

We then had a briefing along with the CCC DA's Office about the case. This case was being co-investigated with the CCC District Attorney's office. After the briefing, Detectives from APD and Investigators from the CCC DA's Office were partnered up and tasked with different responsibilities.

Detective Stenger was tasked with authoring an affidavit applying for a search warrant for the home at 4157 Folsom Drive etc. After the search warrant was issued by the Honorable Judge Mills, I responded with several investigators to serve the search warrant. When I arrived, I was tasked with searching the upstairs bedroom located on the north/east side of the hallway. This bedroom was next door to the grandmothers bedroom and was over the garage looking onto Folsom Drive. In this room was a mattress, dresser, TV, and TV stand. There were several bags of clothing inside the closet as well as several boxes of shoes. Next to the mattress was a wooden stool that had a large fan that was directed toward the mattress/window.

While searching the room, I did not locate paperwork that had any names or items of indicia that would show ownership to the room. There were clothes for what appeared to be mostly women and kids with some clothing appearing to belong to a man, but not many.

While searching the closet, I located an unloaded .300 cal rifle. This rifle was under several bags of clothes and was completely concealed. I had Cpl. Pfeiffer photograph the rifle then I removed it from the closet and later placed it into the trunk of my APD vehicle. I did not locate anything else during this search.

We returned to APD where I checked the serial number on the firearm and found no match as far as ownership. The firearm was not listed as being stolen. I later logged the rifle into evidence at APD.

On 7/29/2014, I learned that Officer Ward took photographs of briefing bulletin's regarding the PC to arrest on Randolph, his vehicle, license plate of vehicle, and a photo of Randolph. I met with Officer Ward at APD where he provided me with the photos he took on his phone. I downloaded the photos he took regarding the briefing bulletin and submitted them into evidence.

I was partnered with Det. Hewitt and we were tasked with obtaining the 911 call and all police radio traffic related to this incident. In addition we were tasked with attempting to locate any video surveillance in the area of Wildhorse Rd and Folsom Drive.

I obtained and downloaded the 911 call made from RP- [REDACTED] In summary [REDACTED] called the police to report that he had located a rifle in the roadway on Folsom Drive near Kern St. [REDACTED] advised he collected the rifle and had it in his possession and was going to stand by with the rifle until police could arrive. For further details refer to the CD, which I logged into evidence at APD.

I then obtained a copy of the police radio traffic. In listening to the radio traffic, I could hear Officer Ward (X23) being dispatched to event #14-69049. The details of the event were not broadcasted over the radio. A short time later, Ofc. McDonald (K9-6) was dispatched to cover Ofc. Ward.

After several minutes go by, Ofc. Ward advised he located the white SUV being driven by a BMA and provided a license plate of [REDACTED]. Ofc. Ward stated via radio he was going to affect an enforcement stop and "light him up," which is a common term to mean activate his lights and siren.

On 07/27/14 at about 0850 hours, I heard Ofc. Ward broadcast over the police radio that there were shots fired. Several other officers and I responded code 3 to assist. While enroute to the call I noticed the original call for service was for a found property rifle found in the street on Folsom Drive. I immediately remembered that there was a briefing bulletin for ARR-Timothy Randolph who lives on Folsom Drive and is wanted for PC 245 (case 14-7019) where he had shot a gun at someone in car. There was probable cause for his arrest and he was considered armed and dangerous. There were also two robberies that he was the suspect in (14-7006 and 14-6997). I suspected that this incident may involve Randolph as it occurred on his street.

I arrived and noticed two patrol cars parked near 4157 Folsom Drive. I parked by patrol vehicle along the West curb line of Folsom Drive. I had my shotgun with me and exited my patrol vehicle. I noticed Ofc. Ward and Ofc. McDonald were standing in front of the garage of 4157 Folsom Drive. I ran to this location and noticed there was a black male adult lying on the floor of the garage near the inside garage door to the house. He was next to a white Chevy Tahoe with the driver door open.

I assisted by covering the inside garage door while other officers did a safety check of the house.

Once the house was clear I assisted with crime scene security. Reserve Sgt. Rupani maintained the scene security log.

WIT- [REDACTED] approached me at the crime scene and told me the following in summary.

About 30 minutes before this incident he drove by 4157 Folsom Drive and noticed a white male adult carrying a rifle in his left hand. The rifle appeared to have wooden stock that he been shortened or "sawed off." The WMA appeared to be walking away from 4157 Folsom Drive and got into a white pickup truck with 4 doors.

party.

I spoke to the next door neighbor who lives at [REDACTED], OTH-[REDACTED], who told me the following in summary.

Randolph [REDACTED] lives at 4157 Folsom Drive. Randolph is very aggressive and has challenged him to fight several times. He tries to avoid Randolph but on 07/02/14 when he was driving his car away from his house. Randolph used his white Chevy Tahoe (he pointed at the Tahoe parked in the garage Lic [REDACTED]) to stop him on Wild Horse Road at Folsom Drive. He pulled the white Tahoe in front of him cutting him off and stopped directly in front of him blocking him from driving. Randolph got out of his car and walked up to his driver side window.

Randolph accused him of painting on the sidewalk (which he did not do) and told him that he would kill anyone who came to his house. The next day on 07/03/14, he found 6 .22 cal rimfire shell casings which he collected and kept in a zip lock bag. He believes that Randolph left these on his front porch as a threat.

Since this incident he has heard gun shots from the back yard of 4157 Folsom Drive on multiple occasions. It sounds like a small caliber gun and he hears 5-6 shots fired off rapidly.

He does not call the police on Randolph because he is afraid that Randolph may shoot his house. He is afraid for his wife and child and does not want to upset Randolph. He [REDACTED] feels that Randolph will blame anything that happens on him like he blamed the paint on the sidewalk on him.

[REDACTED] gave me the shell casings that he had collected. I inspected them and there were 6, Super X .22 cal rim fire casings. I later booked the casings into evidence. I booked them in the zip lock baggy that [REDACTED] had them in as they had already been inside this bag for nearly a month.

I took no further action.

My attention was drawn to this call for service (found property) by the APD Dispatch Center when they detailed it over the radio. Dispatch assigned the detail to Ofc. Ward and announced the particulars over the radio.

I reviewed the detail's event screen in the CAD screen. I am familiar with the area of Spaulding Drive and know that it is in the Wildhorse neighborhood off of Wildhorse Drive and Folsom Drive.

This was of particular concern for me because I knew of some pending investigations that revolved around that neighborhood. Specifically, 4157 Folsom Drive.

On 07-21-14, Timothy Randolph had been identified as a responsible in a vehicle shooting, and it was reported that he used a long rifle. I met with the investigating officer that day (Ofc. Matis) and reviewed the case with him. I learned that Timothy Randolph was identified as the responsible in that shooting (PC 246/PC 245(a)(2), and he was driving a white Chevy Tahoe.

I also knew Randolph from numerous prior police contacts and arrests, and knew him to be violent towards police officers and citizens, to flee from police officers, and to be involved in different shootings. I have contacted Randolph driving the same Chevy Tahoe in the past when he was attempting to evade police contact after he was shot at. I knew Randolph to have a listed address at 4157 Folsom Drive, and there was also a recent domestic dispute there where Randolph was identified as the responsible yet again.

I contacted APD Dispatch and requested that additional units be dispatched to that area. I requested that while an officer contacts the R/P in this case to recover the "loaded rifle," that other officers conduct an area check for Timothy Randolph and the white Chevy Tahoe.

Shortly after the call was dispatched I heard Ofc. Ward notify dispatch over the radio that he had located the Tahoe driving in the neighborhood. Ofc. Ward followed the Tahoe, which began driving erratically. I left the station and began to drive to the area.

I heard Ofc. Ward give a partial license plate over the radio, and then over his transmissions I heard his siren as he attempted to stop the vehicle. Ofc. Ward stated the vehicle made a u-turn on Wildhorse Drive, and then went to the house on Folsom Drive.

We knew exactly where the house was at from the prior shooting incident and our area checks. Also, just the day before we had a residential burglary alarm next door which I responded to (with the dispatched units) for support.

Ofc. Ward transmitted that Randolph was in the garage and trying to go into the house. I advised to have the available responding units support Ofc. Ward, and (if and when Randolph fled into the house) to set up a perimeter on the house with long rifle containment.

Shortly after that, Ofc Ward advised that shots were fired, and he requested "Code 3 Cover." Ofc. Ward advised shots were fired again and requested support. At this time all the available units in the city were responding to the scene.

I heard both Ofc.'s Ward and McDonald advise that there may be a gun in the garage or in the trunk of the Tahoe. I requested to have ConFire and AMR personnel respond to the area and stage until the scene could be made safe and secure.

As we arrived on scene I saw Randolph down on the garage floor towards the inner door to the residence. Randolph was moved to the mouth of the garage and officers began covering down on the front of the residence. I waited for additional police units to arrive to support us. Sgt. Castillo was on-scene and coordinated the inner perimeter at the front of the house, and I coordinated a team of officers to evacuate the house, and then conduct a safety "security" sweep of the residence and property.

Several adult females, and (2) children exited the house upon our PA announcements. Afterwards, I entered the residence through the front door with several other officers. We searched and cleared the downstairs living areas, the garage, the upstairs living areas, and then the backyard.

We did not encounter any other persons. Afterwards, I requested that the ConFire and AMR personnel standing-by respond to the scene to render first-aid to Randolph.

Randolph was evaluated by the paramedics and then prepared to be transported to a local hospital (JMMC) for treatment.

A crime scene log was started, and traffic control into the area. I requested the assistance of a Brentwood PD unit to contact the original R/P and secure the "found" rifle. That was completed and the rifle was secured in the truck of APD patrol car #1227, Sgt. Castillo's vehicle.

After the scene was established and secured the APD's Officer Involved Critical Incident Protocol was invoked for the remaining investigation. Refer to the APD Investigation Bureau's reports.

I took no further action.

The next time she saw Timothy, he was yelling on the ground near the driveway in the garage. [REDACTED] thought she heard Timothy yell "Alright... Alright..." [REDACTED] stated she thought she heard 3 to 5 gunshots and she thought they were random.

[REDACTED] was asked if she ever saw Timothy carry any guns, and she told me "He (referring to Timothy) has never done anything around me where I would think he'd carry a gun."

[REDACTED] stated when she and Timothy are together, they laugh, hang out, talk, he calms her down if she becomes upset regarding her daughter. this incident today, that she learned [REDACTED] was not his name and his real name was Timothy.

I made contact with group which was standing in front of Contra Costa County Fire Station 88. I identified myself by name and agency and obtained the names of the four adult females and the two children. The subjects were identified as [REDACTED] [REDACTED] (6 years) and [REDACTED] (1 year). I advised them they would be transported to the Police Department for interviews. They agreed and [REDACTED] added that [REDACTED] had Alzheimer's and would know anything.

me she thinks he does use a stronger drug because Timothy is up all night and never sleeps. She told me he's a peeping tom and peeks on them while they're sleeping. [REDACTED] told me she was glad Timothy was gone, but she didn't want him to get shot. I asked her if she was surprised this happened between Timothy and Police and she told me no. She told me she is not surprised because Timothy is "crazy."

My conversation with [REDACTED] ended when we arrived at the Police Department. I recorded the conversation and attached the recording to this report.

Assignments

After residents from 4157 Folsom Drive were transported to the Police Department to await interviews. I attended a briefing along with other Antioch Police personnel and Investigators with the Contra Costa County District Attorney's Office. During this briefing information about this incident, the involved parties and original call for service were provided. Also teams were established and assignments were given.

I was partnered with Ins. Holcombe (CCDA) and we were assigned to contact fire personnel, ambulance personnel and the medical helicopter (Cal Star) crew. We were later tasked with contacting Timothy's mother, [REDACTED].

We made several attempts to contact ConFire personnel from station 81, but were not successful as they had a busy shift. We were successful contacting the ambulance crew and the helicopter crew and Ins. Holcombe obtained their statements. (Refer to Ins. Holcombe supplement report).

the internet. [REDACTED] stated she understood the procedures and wanted to know Timothy's condition and what had happened. [REDACTED] then explained what information she learned from the incident.

As I spoke with [REDACTED] I explained Timothy was okay and at the time was still in surgery. I also briefly explained the protocol of an Officer-Involved-Shooting and the process of the investigation. In speaking with [REDACTED] I asked her information about Timothy. Below is a summary of my conversation with [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] stated on Saturday Timothy called her said he was going to church. She stated Sunday morning he called about times of services. [REDACTED] said after church, Timothy called her and they talked about church services. She believed the service had an impact on him because he didn't say much. [REDACTED] told me that was the last she heard of from him.

I asked [REDACTED] to tell me about Timothy's mental state and background. She told me Timothy had been shot two years ago by a kid. [REDACTED] said because of the incident Timothy is paranoid (hyper aware). She explained he is always looking around, doesn't like when people come up on him and doesn't like loud noise. [REDACTED] also told me h Timothy doesn't like people looking at him. I asked what caused the shooting two years ago. [REDACTED] told me it started with an argument. During the argument the suspect displayed a gun. [REDACTED] stated Timothy told the suspect to fight him, not to use the gun. She stated the suspect shot Timothy anyway.

I asked about Timothy having problems with anyone. [REDACTED] stated Timothy has had issues with his child's mother ([REDACTED]). [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] and her boyfriend (name unknown) tried to kill Timothy. [REDACTED] stated Timothy went to Kaiser to met [REDACTED] for lunch. She told me she didn't know of him to carry guns, but at one time gave him a box cutter that he asked for. [REDACTED] also told me Timothy didn't start fights, but would fight if he had to. On 7/28/14, I responded to APD after learning of this Officer Involved Shooting. After attending a briefing, I was partnered with Detective Vanderpool and Senior Inspector Hendershot. We were assigned to interview Officer Ward, Officer McDonald, Wit- [REDACTED], and Wit- [REDACTED].

Prior to conducting interviews, we responded to the scene of the shooting and viewed the entire scene. We then responded back to APD to conduct interviews.

Detective Vanderpool, Senior Inspector Hendershot and I conducted an interview with Officer McDonald at 1326hrs. The interview took place in the APD lobby interview room. The interview was digitally recorded and is attached to this report. For exact details of the interview, refer to the digital recording. Below is a summary of Officer McDonald's statement:

He has been a police officer for six years and attended a POST approved police academy. His current work schedule is 0700-1900hrs, Sunday through Tuesday and every other Saturday. He is currently assigned to patrol, but also serves as a K-9 Officer, SWAT team member, and Firearms Instructor. He has attended training schools to include an 80 hours SWAT course, a month long K-9 School, and a 40 hour rifle instructor course.

During the incident today, he had a citizen ride-along in his patrol vehicle. The ride-along's name was [REDACTED].

His day started today with briefing at 0700hrs. After briefing, Dispatch notified him that his ride-along, [REDACTED], was waiting for him in the APD Lobby. He knew [REDACTED] from high school (Antioch High) and also knew that [REDACTED] was an applicant with APD.

They were driving around the city and he was showing [REDACTED] around, and showing [REDACTED] what he did on a daily basis. He stopped at the "Bonfare Market" to get a water when he was dispatched to this call.

The details in the call were that a rifle was found laying in the middle of the street at the intersection of Folsom Dr and Wildhorse Dr. He knew that there were prior contacts with a Timothy Randolph near this location. He knew that there was probable cause to arrest Randolph for a PC 246 (Negligent discharge of firearm) and for a domestic violence case. For this reason, this was considered more than just a found property call, and two patrol units were dispatched at the direction of Corporal Fortner. He knew that Randolph was driving a white Chevy Tahoe SUV.

As he was responding, he exited on Hillcrest Ave from E/B Hwy 4. As he was driving S/B on Hillcrest Ave, he heard Officer Ward advise over the radio that he had located Randolph driving on Folsom Dr towards Wildhorse Dr. He activated his overhead emergency lights and responded to that location "code 3" (emergency response).

As he neared Hillcrest Ave and Bellflower Dr, he slowed down so that he would not be caught behind a long center median in case they came towards him. He heard Officer Ward advise that

Randolph was making a u-turn and proceeding N/B on Wildhorse Dr. Officer Ward also started requesting "code 3" cover, and was advising that Randolph was traveling at slow speeds, but not yielding to his lights/sirens. He proceeded with lights and sirens to Officer Ward's location.

Next he heard Officer Ward put out over the radio that Randolph was pulling into the driveway of his house. Officer Ward said again over the radio that he needed "code 3" cover.

When he finally pulled up to the residence, he saw Officer Ward's vehicle parked slightly before the house on Folsom Dr. He parked his vehicle behind Officer Ward's vehicle in the middle of the street.

As he exited his vehicle, he heard 7-10 gunshots coming from the driveway. He did not initially know where Randolph and Officer Ward were, so he ran up the driveway towards the direction of the gunshots. His view upon exiting his vehicle was blocked by an overgrown bush and several vehicles parked in the driveway and he did not know who was shooting at who. He could see that Randolph's vehicle was inside the garage, but he couldn't see Officer Ward or Randolph.

He located Officer Ward standing outside the garage, holding Randolph at gunpoint. Officer Ward was yelling, "Let me see your hands, let me see your hands!" Officer Ward and Randolph were in the garage, with the garage door wide open. Randolph was down on the ground, near the steps that lead into the residence from the garage. He could see that Randolph was bleeding. Randolph was trying to get up, so he and Officer Ward kept yelling at Randolph to stay on the ground and show them his hands.

There was a box spring mattress on the ground near Randolph. He heard officer Ward say that he thought Randolph took something out of his pocket and dumped it near the box spring. Randolph also kept rolling over and placing his hands underneath his body.

Officer Ward held down on Randolph, while he cleared the car in the garage to make sure that no one else was inside. Once that was cleared, he told Randolph that they needed him to be as cooperative as possible. He explained to Randolph that medical personnel was on the way, and the sooner they could place him in handcuffs, the sooner they could render the scene safe so that he could get medical treatment. Randolph said "okay", but then still tried to get up two-three more times. He continued to give Randolph commands to stay on the ground and keep his hands where they could see them. Randolph was leaning over the box spring and it was obstructing their view of him. They went up and pulled the box spring out of the way. Randolph was still not in handcuffs because it was not safe enough to go "hands on" with him yet.

Someone had opened the inner garage door and people also started opening the front door to the residence, so they were also dealing with trying to keep those subjects inside.

At one point he asked Randolph if he had a gun on him or if he dumped one. Randolph said he didn't have a gun, but there was one in the trunk of his car. Since he was right there, he opened the

back of the Tahoe to look inside, but did not see a gun. He confirmed with Randolph if he was sure he didn't have a gun because it wasn't in the trunk. Randolph said that the gun was actually in the back seat.

When Officer Bedgood and Officer Dee arrived on scene, they had enough people to safely handcuff Randolph. He and Officer McDonald approached Randolph and placed him into handcuffs. He did a pat-down search of Randolph and did not locate anything of note on Randolph's person. He did notice that there was live ammunition on the garage floor where Randolph was laying. It appeared to be 9mm handgun ammo. They pulled Randolph out of the garage.

They then set up on the front door and used a loudspeaker to call everyone out of the residence. They called four adult females and two children out of the house. Once everyone was out, they entered the house to clear it. No one else was located inside and he did not notice anything of note in plain view.

He does not recall if he has had any personal contact with Randolph in the past. He has seen pictures of Randolph from briefing bulletins and he did recognize Randolph when he saw him.

I asked Officer McDonald if Officer Ward made any statement to him about the shooting at the scene. Officer McDonald said that Officer Ward told him Randolph got out of the car and reached for his waistband and pulled something out that Officer Ward believed to be a gun. Based on Randolph's history of violence, Officer Ward being by himself, and the garage not being well lit, Officer Ward said that he had to shoot Randolph.

The interview concluded at 1345hrs.
