We do not control any intersection cameras or other outside traffic cameras within Richmond County. Those are managed by Richmond County Traffic Engineering. I have been advised in the past that the equipment that is mounted on the traffic lights are sensors and do not record footage. You may want to contact them to confirm.

In reference to your request for the report, are you an involved party (driver, Vehicle owner, insuring party, or witness)? Open Records Law limits access to Motor Vehicle accident reports.
