Hi Dick,

I had you on my call list today.

I checked the witness statements and reviewed the police report. According to the narrative, Jamie was stopped just past checkout as you stated. However, upon being stopped, she voluntarily pulled other items out of her purse. There is a receipt available that shows all items that were allegedly concealed.

I also checked on the GCIC record and when that goes on the GCIC. It is entered by the Sheriff when someone is booked into the jail/arrested. So, that will be on her record already. With that said, it can be removed if the record of the arrest is expunged. Our clerk can handle the expungement documentation once the case is disposed of, as long as it is a dismissal or not guilty. She has paperwork which can be completed at the time of disposition.

Based on the nature of Jamie's employment, lack of criminal history, and the circumstances of the case, I am agreeable to pretrial diversion. In order to expedite the process, she will need to take a shoplifting awareness class, which is available online and costs \$75.00. If she brings the certificate of completion to Court on 11/17, I will add this to her file and she will have completed the program's requirements. There won't be a fee other than the cost of taking the class. I will then double check her criminal history to make sure there are no other infractions, and dismiss the case accordingly. We can then process the forms for expungement so it is completed ASAP.

The site for the class is www.shopliftingprevention.org. She will choose "Enroll in Theft Class" for adults. The link should be near the top. She will select voluntarily complete the online class. She won't choose the court ordered case option since we don't have a Court Order, as this is Pre-Trial case. The courses are the same however. The length of the class should be 3-4 hours. Jamie can pay the fee online, follow the instructions and should be able to print the form at home. As long as this is complete by 11/17 and brought to Court, we will dismiss the case as a completed PTD.

I will be in the Courtroom on 11/17. Jamie will check in with me at the counsel table and we will handle everything then. As long as she is there by 840 am, she can avoid the major crowd.

1. O.C.G.A. §35-3-37 provides for the restriction of certain criminal history records for non-criminal justice purposes when approved by the prosecuting attorney.
 - For arrests prior to July 1, 2013 the applicant is required to apply for restriction at the arresting agency. Arresting agencies may require a processing fee not to exceed \$50.00 as authorized per §35-3-37.
 - The REQUEST TO RESTRICT ARREST RECORD is a three section (page) form.
 - Section One is completed by the applicant. Each request form may contain only one (1) Date of Arrest (there may be multiple charges for that arrest).
 - Section Two is completed by the arresting agency. The entire form is forwarded to the prosecutor for approval/denial.
 - Section Three is completed by the prosecutor. If approved, the prosecutor may enter the appropriate disposition restriction code using the GCIC CCH User Interface and notify the applicant that the restriction is complete. The arresting agency will receive a notification from GCIC that the record has been restricted. *If the prosecutor enters the restriction in the CCH User Interface the application and fee should not be forwarded to GCIC.*
 - If the prosecutor does not have access to the CCH User Interface, the application may be returned to the arresting agency.
 - The arresting agency should advise the applicant to forward the *approved* application to GCIC including the GCIC processing fee. Incomplete applications or those missing the required fee will not be processed and will be returned to the applicant. Do not forward the restriction application to GCIC if the request is denied by the prosecutor.
 - Applicants may send the approved Request to Restrict Arrest Record form and \$25.00 fee (money order or certified check payable to "Georgia Bureau of Investigation") to:

- GCIC will send an email notification to the applicant email address listed on Page 1 of the application when the restriction has been applied to the Georgia criminal history. GCIC does not mail notifications or provide copies of an approved Request to Restrict Arrest Record application.
 - To check the status of a request, contact the GCIC CCH/Identification Services Helpdesk at (404) 244-2639, Option 1 or email gacriminalhistory@gbj.ga.gov
2. For arrests occurring July 1, 2013 or later, there is no application process. The prosecutor may approve the restriction at the time of sentencing. If restriction is approved upon sentence completion, it should be noted in the sentencing documentation forwarded to the court.
 3. When the restriction has been applied to the Georgia criminal history, access to that specific arrest cycle is restricted for non-criminal justice purposes (Employment/Licensing). However, such information may be available through other sources. GCIC has no control over information provided by local agencies or private vendors.

Important! In this case, a positive match of the person whose criminal history record is sought requires submission of fingerprint cards to GCIC. When conducting a fingerprint search for criminal history record information, the information returned does, in fact, belong to the individual.
