On 092209, I was traveling North on I-575 and was in the right lane behind a van. I have spoken with Mr. Cooper, Cpl Wells and reviewed the video. I find that the citation issued was within Cpl Wells' authority to issue. Mr. Cooper's main reason for the complaint was an effort to have the citation withdrawn. I advised Mr. Cooper that I would not do that and his only recourse was with the court system here in Cherokee County.

I do find fault with Cpl Wells with the innappropriate use of profanity towards Mr. Cooper. I understand Cpl Wells' hightened adrenaline but restraint was needed. Cpl Wells has received a verbal counseling on this issue.

Cpl Wells has proven himself as a leader in the Traffic Unit and always acted professional; I believe this is an isolated incident.
