On Sunday, August 26, 2018 at 1950 hrs I Officer Davis along with Officer Hietala were dispatched to [REDACTED] in reference to a domestic dispute called in by a third party.

Prior to arrival we activated our body worn and in car camera systems. Upon arrival, contact was made with Mr Rocco who resides at [REDACTED] and placed the call for the victim Ms. Tiffany Davis. Rocco stated that Davis came running to his front door requesting he call the police for her because she was involved in a physical altercation with her boyfriend/primary aggressor Mr. Jonathan Sharp.

Davis came from the inside of the residence limping with her sandals broken. Davis stated that while at their residence of [REDACTED] her and Sharp got into a verbal dispute in the bedroom. Davis stated that she moved Sharp's clothes from off the floor to a bin where his clothes were located. Sharp then asked where his work uniform was located and when Davis advised in his clothing bin, Sharp asked Davis "why are you so mean" and Davis stated she was not mean. The dispute continued and Davis went into the kitchen area and over heard Sharp tell his cousin [REDACTED] Sharp) who was also at the residence that "he could not take this shit anymore and that he was leaving". Davis stated she told Sharp he would be doing her a favor by leaving. Davis then stated she went to grab the infant child from Sharp while he was gathering his clothes from the bedroom and Sharp did not want to release the infant.

Sharp did admit to pushing Davis in order to protect the infant, from all the noise. Juvenile 1 came from the kitchen area to the bedroom and Davis advised him to leave. Davis stated she began calling the cousin of Sharp (Patrick Sharp) who was still in kitchen area of the residence who stated later that he only saw Sharp shielding off Davis so she would not be able to get the infant. Sharp's cousin then grabbed the infant child when he noticed things beginning to become physical between Sharp and Davis. Patrick then took the infant into the kitchen area where he gave him to juvenile 1.

Davis stated once the infant was gone, Sharp pushed her over a clothes bin causing her to fall and landing on her side/stomach. During the fall, Davis injured her left foot. After the altercation, Davis was later transported to Archbold Medical Hospital. It was determined that Davis suffered from a broken toe.

During the struggle, Davis stated Sharp choked her from behind causing her to suffer from a lack of oxygen. The injuries to Davis' neck appeared to be finger nail scratch imprints on the left side of her neck. Davis was unable to identify if one or two hands were being used by Sharp during the struggle. Photos were taken of the injuries Davis sustained and uploaded to the "p" drive.

Davis stated she was able to get free and run to the neighbor's house where she advised him to call the police. Sharp and his cousin then left the residence and relocated to 104 Duren Dr. which is the residence of Sharp's mother.

Davis, while being treated by EMS had Ms. Pam Hancock come get her two oldest children and the infant remained with her during treatment.

Davis was transported to Archbold Medical Hospital by Thomas County EMS. The information was passed on to Thomas County Sheriff Deputies and to locate and arrest Mr. Sharp. Sgt Antes of the Thomas County Sheriff Department was advised to place Sharp under arrest for Battery Family Violence and Cruelty of children times two..

Sharp was then transported to Thomas County Jail by Sgt. Antes after making contact at Sharp's mothers residence.

Davis was given a Crime Victim Bill Of Rights pamphlet and provided a case number for reference.

Detective Newberry was advised of the circumstances of the case and advised we should arrest Sharp and a detective would conduct a interview the next day.

Davis advised she would provide a written statement which she has not completed at this time. She would notify the police when it is completed the next date.
