

ORDER ON STATE'S MOTION TO EXCLUDE INADMISSIBLE CHARACTER
EVIDENCE

The above motion was before the Court for a hearing on May 21, 2024. The defendant was present and represented by counsel Tracy Drake, and the state was represented by appointed special prosecutor Brandon Delfunt. After a discussion on the record, the state and defendant agreed to the following:

References to the victim Susana Morales leaving home voluntarily for certain periods of time are admissible at trial. Additionally, references to the victim Susana Morales having smoked marijuana are admissible. A reference to Susana Morales trying another drug on one occasion may be admissible if a proper evidentiary foundation is laid. All other character evidence references listed in the state's motion shall not be admissible and shall be excluded from trial.
