NARRATIVE

On 043019 at 2035hrs. I, Deputy John Tarpley (6314/C683) responded in the area of Barton Chapel and Milledgeville Rd. in reference to a suspicious person in the roadway. Upon arrival, I drove around in the area attempting to locate the suspicious person. I proceeded into the Sprint Gas Station 2202 Gordon Hwy. I located the suspicious person sitting on the sidewalk in the parking lot with multiple bags. I approached and identified the person as the one that was called in. The suspect identified herself as Deanna Taylor. I spoke with Ms. Taylor and asked her what her purpose of being in the parking lot was. Ms. Taylor stated that she was trying to get to a nearby gas station to rest. Ms. Taylor explained to me that she had been homeless in Augusta for a year now and wants to get back to her home in Missouri. When searching her name on my MDT I found that she has a history of drug possession. I asked Ms. Taylor if she had any drugs on her person or in her bags. Ms. Taylor stated she does not. I asked her if I could search her bags and she stated that she did not give me consent to search. I explained to Ms. Taylor that I have suspicion that she does have drugs on her or in her bags and that I was going to get a K-9 unit to search.

Dep. Flanders (K-4) along with K-9 Blecky arrived on scene. Blecky gave a positive response of drugs in one of Ms. Taylor's bags. At this time, Ms. Taylor gave consent to search her belongings.

When searching her bags, an unknown white substance was found in a tin can along with 4 empty needles and 4 clear pipes.

The white substance was then field tested positive for Methamphetamine by K-4. The methamphetamine was weighed in at approximately 1.1 grams.

At this time, Ms. Taylor was placed under arrest for possession of Methamphetamine and transported to RCJ.

Methamphetamine was turned into drug locker under property receipt #464083.
Paraphnilia was turned into evidence locker under property receipt #464084
