On June 15th, 2020, I was requested by Adel Police Department with helping locate an individual by the name of Charles Dunwoody wanted by the Feds possibly on West 6th and South MLK under a wooden outbuilding with several other individuals. Cpl. Katlyn Sumner advised that the FBI agent advised that the subject was the only male wearing a dark in color ball cap and would elude if he had a chance to get away.

Upon arrival Cpl. Will Gates, Deputy Joey Gatewood, Deputy Kyle Brewer, and I stood by with several individuals who was located under the wooden gazebo, while Adel police Department officers approached a black male located on the east side of the gazebo with a dark in color ball cap. I made contact with a Bobby Kiser and asked if he knew the subject's names that Police Department was speaking with, he advised "No". While standing by helping with crowd control I could hear Adel PD officers asking the male for his identification. I then heard Adel units ask the male to stand up and place his hands behind his back when the male stood up, he began resisting arrest. I heard a taser being used while officers were trying to place the male into custody before falling to the ground. Adel officers continued to try and place the male into custody using a taser and closed hand strikes, but the male was very uncooperative refusing to place his hands behind his back. I then moved from the back side of the gazebo to the side where the officers and subject was on the ground and advised the officers to let me speak with the subject. I also asked the subject to stop resisting and place his hands behind his back. The PD Officers eventually got the subjects hands behind his back and placed them into hand cuffs and done a search of his person. The subject began yelling that his wrist was hurting due to the handcuffs. Adel PD officers placed the subject into a patrol unit and called for EMS. We stood by and helped with crowd control while Adel PD officers collected evidence. The subject was transported to the Cook County Sheriff's Office.

On June 15, 2020, around 1900 hours I, Cpl Gates assisted other deputies and Adel Police Department with locating an individual around 6th and S. MLK who was a person of interest by the Feds. Upon arriving I, stood by with several individuals who were located under a gazebo while Adel PD began speaking to the men. Sgt. Clayton Godwin and I were given permission to enter a small outbuilding by one of the men there who Sgt Godwin knew, but located no one inside. We rejoined everyone back at the gazebo where Adel PD was speaking to a male about his identity. I then heard Adel units tell the man to stand up and place his hands behind his back. Adel units attempted to place the man into custody however he began resisting. I saw an Adel PD officer utilize his taser in a drive stun and the man then went to the ground but continued to resist and tried to get up all while yelling and screaming. Adel Officers continued to try and place the male into custody by utilizing a taser and closed hand punches to the male. The other County Officers and I were standing by in an attempt to control the growing crowd, when one individual under the gazebo began getting loud and at one time looked like he was going to intervene. He stood up aggressively with a closed fist and yelled, but then left the area. Sgt Godwin and Deputy J. Gatewood then tried to intervene and attempt to talk with the offender, and Deputy Gatewood then grabbed the offender's legs as he was kicking around. The subject was finally controlled and placed into handcuffs, searched, and placed into the rear of the patrol car. Due to the large growing crowd, evidence was collected by Adel PD and the subject was taken to the Cook County Jail to be checked by EMS.

I Deputy Brewer on 06/15/2020 was notified that the feds were looking for an individual at 6th St and Martin Luther king Drive. Upon arrival I assisted Adel Police Department and other Deputies. I spotted Adel Police Officers on a gazebo, when I got closer I saw Officer Green and Sgt. Hancock on the gazebo trying to identify a subject. The subject began to become belligerent (yelling and cussing), one of the Adel Officers asked him to stand up and the subject would not comply with lawful commands. The subject and the Adel Officers began tousling, there was a different subject wearing a black shirt on the gazebo that was becoming enraged over the incident and at one time stood up in an aggressive manner. Sgt Godwin was able to calm him down. It was at that time I walked towards the road to deal with the growing crowd. While watching the perimeter I could hear the struggle behind me along with the sound of a taser. I could not make out who had the taser Once the Adel Officers were able to get the subject into custody, they walked him over too one of the squad cars. The subject was complaining about the handcuffs being too tight and that his wrist were hurting. One of the Adel Officers fixed the handcuffs and placed him in the rear of the squad car. Ems was notified and met the Adel Officers at the Cook County Jail to clear him of any injuries.

On June 16, 2020 Deputies were asked by Adel Police department to help located an individual (black male with dark ball cap) that was wanted by the FBI. Deputies and APD units went to the intersection of 6th and S MLK to attempt in locating the subject. APD officers were talking to 4 individuals under a gazebo and one that matched the description given to APD. I, Deputy Gatewood came around the back side of the gazebo and stood while officers attempted to get the person of interest information. The male was not complying to the officer's verbal commands and was asked to stand up and place his hands behind his back. The male actively resisted the officers verbal command and began to pull away. One of the APD Officer then drive stunned the male to gain control of his hands, which did not work, and the male was still actively resisting. The officers then took the male to the ground. On the ground the male laid on his hands and began to yell. Sgt Godwin attempted to talk to the male to male but with not luck. I noticed that Sgt Futch was being kicked by the male, so for officer safety I grabbed his legs so that he would not kick another officer, while trying to calm him down. At that Time Cpl Sumner stated that the male was going for his waistline. At that moment officers did not know what the male had on his person. Officers were then able to place handcuff on the male and was placed in the back of an APD patrol car. Deputies continued to provide crowd control until the male was transported to the jail to be checked out by EMS.
