Sgt. Lee's Investigative Comments:
Sgt. Lee was aware that a task force was put together to search the CBWDC for contraband such as cell phones, drugs, and weapons. The task force was put together due to an ongoing criminal investigation where several RCSO Deputy Jailers were arrested for bringing in contraband and that same investigation also revealed that several inmates had "shanks" and other homemade weapons throughout the jail. Sgt. Lee reviewed the jail security camera and observed Cpl. Phillips did not touch Naji during the strip search and interviewed Inv. Bale who was with Cpl. Phillips who stated no comments were made to Naji. CBWDC policy for searching inmates attached. Sgt. Lee reminded Cpl Phillips and Inv. Bale the importance of searching inmates in private or sequestered areas when possible.
