AFFIDAVIT HAVING BEEN MADE before me by Logan Holland, an officer charged with the duty of enforcing the Criminal Laws of the State of Georgia, who has probable cause to believe that in Peach County on the following described person, premises or property:

THERE IS NOW LOCATED OR BEING CONCEALED certain papers, persons, human biological materials, instruments, articles or things, any information or data, and anything that is tangible or intangible, corporeal or incorporeal, visible or invisible evidence of the commission of the crime(s) for which probable cause is shown, namely;

Finger, hand, palm, and heel prints, which will be obtained using ink, powder, or other substances used to obtain latent prints.

WHICH ARE subject to seizure pursuant to O.C.G.A. Section 17-5-21, to wit:

- instruments, articles, or things, including private papers of any person, which are designed, intended for use, or which have been used in the commission of the offense in connection with which the warrant is issued [O.C.G.A. Section 17-5-21(a)(1)];
- person who has been kidnapped in violation of the laws of this state, who has been kidnapped in another jurisdiction and is now concealed within this state, or any human fetus or human corpse [O.C.G.A. Section 17-5-21(a)(2)];
- stolen or embezzled property [O.C.G.A. Section 17-5-21(a)(3)];

item, substance, object, thing, or matter, the possession of which is unlawful [O.C.G.A. Section 17-5-21(a)(4)];

instruments, articles or things, any information or data, and anything that is tangible or intangible, corporeal or incorporeal, visible or invisible evidence of the commission of the crime for which probable cause is shown, other than the private papers of any person [O.C.G.A. Section 17-5-21(a)(5)],

And which constitutes a criminal violation of law pursuant to the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, to wit:

O.C.G.A. 16-10-1, O.C.G.A. 16-7-23 Criminal Damage to property in the second degree; O.C.G.A. Section 16-2-20, Party to a Crime; O.C.G.A. Section 16-4-8, Conspiracy to Commit a Crime; O.C.G.A. Section 16-4-1, Criminal Attempt to Commit a Crime; O.C.G.A. Section 16-4-7, Criminal Solicitation;

Based upon the affidavit given under oath or affirmation and all other evidence given to me under oath or affirmation, I am satisfied that there is probable cause to believe that a crime is being committed or has been committed and that the property described above is presently located on the person, premises, or property described above.

YOU ARE HEREBY COMMANDED to enter, search and seize within ten (10) days of this date, the person, premises, or property described above. A copy of this Warrant is to be left with the person searched, or if no person is available, on the premises or vehicle searched, and a written return, including an inventory of any things seized, shall be made before me or a Court of competent jurisdiction without unnecessary delay after the execution of this Search Warrant.

If said warrant has not been executed within ten (10) days from the date of this order, the said warrant shall be returned to the undersigned judicial officer without unnecessary delay following the expiration of said period of time, excepting only to electronic devices that necessitate specialized forensic examination in order to execute said warrant.
