When GRIFFIN, the shift sergeant/team leader, found subordinate jail staff had placed INMATE THOMAS in the shower with the water turned on and directed at INMATE THOMAS'S head and face, she did not order her subordinates to stop, allowing their actions toward INMATE THOMAS to continue.
