On October 21, 2013, the U.S. Probation Officer petitioned the Court requesting that a warrant be issued for the arrest of Fabian Keith Notto. The Petition charged the defendant with failure to refrain from the violation of Federal, State, or Local Law. The defendant was arrested on October 8, 2013, by the Chatham-Savannah Counter Narcotics Team (CNT) for the offenses of Possession of a Controlled Substance with Intent to Distribute and Possession of Marijuana with Intent to Distribute.

The defendant was also under the jurisdiction of the State of Georgia Probation authorities and his term of probation was revoked on September 22, 2015, due to the new criminal conduct noted. He served a custody sentence of two (2) years and six (6) months and was released from the Georgia Department of Corrections on April 8, 2016. Additionally, the defendant's term of supervised release was scheduled to close on February 27, 2016.

On July 5, 2016, the defendant appeared in U.S. District Court, District of South Carolina, and he was released on an unsecured bond pending supervised release violation proceedings.

The U.S. Probation Office now respectfully requests that further proceedings against this defendant in this case be dismissed.

Therefore, for reasons sufficient to the Court, it is ordered that the supervised release violation proceedings be dismissed and the term of supervised release shall be closed.
