Narrative

On October 08, 2013 at 1544 hours at Oglethorpe Avenue/Whitaker Street I came in contact with Fabian Notto while backing up Officer Fikes, who was on a traffic stop.

Officer Fikes had a traffic stop at Oglethorpe Avenue/Whitaker Street. I responded as a backup officer. I approached the driver (Mr. Notto) of a grey in color Toyota Tundra. I said hello to Mr. Notto and asked him how he was doing on this day. I could immediately smell a strong odor of marijuana coming from the driver's area of the truck. I advised other officers on scene of what I smelled.

Since the vehicle was still running I asked Mr. Notto if he would turn the vehicle off for me, which Mr. Notto did. I asked Mr. Notto if he would exit the truck for me, Mr. Notto did not respond to me. I asked Mr. Notto again if he would exit the truck for me, Mr. Notto did not respond to me and began to look around the truck. I again asked Mr. Notto to exit the vehicle and as I did Mr. Notto began to reach with his right hand towards the ignition keys that were dangling still inside the ignition. I opened Mr. Notto's driver side door, as I did this Mr. Notto stepped out of the vehicle. I had Mr. Notto exit the truck, walk roughly three feet towards the rear end of the truck and place both of his hands against the truck. I asked Mr. Notto if he had any weapons on his person, which Mr. Notto replied that he did not. I could still smell a strong odor of marijuana that seemed to be coming from Mr. Notto. I asked Mr. Notto if I could search him for weapons, which Mr. Notto replied that I could. As I conducted my search I ran my hand up between Mr. Notto's legs, I could feel Mr. Notto tighten his thigh/butt muscles as I did so, attempting to conceal what I believed was a weapon from me. I asked Mr. Notto to spread his feet further for me, which Mr. Notto did. I again attempted to sweep my hand between Mr. Notto's thighs and could again feel Mr. Notto tighten his thigh/butt muscles as I did so. As I swept my hand between Mr. Notto's thighs I felt something shift in Mr. Notto's shorts. I looked on the ground and saw that a medium (6"x4") clear plastic bag had fallen to the ground.
