The Department requires an investigation into the allegation that Officer Melvin Potter struck an arrestee in the face with handcuffs still in his hand on 06/13/23.

An investigation of the allegations of this complaint, and any other allegations which arose during the investigation, has been completed.

Summary of Complaint:

On 06/13/23 the City of Atlanta Police Department APEX Unit along with the Gangs Unit were conducting a detail at the Allen Temple Apartments. A unit conducting surveillance observed a group of males smoking marijuana at or near the apartment building at 105 Allen Temple Court NW. The surveillance unit relayed this information to nearby officers at approximately 1855 hours. Per BWC footage, Ofc. M. Potter and Ofc. K. Craddock from the APEX Unit were riding together in the same patrol vehicle and they responded to the area where the males were observed. Multiple officers approached the group of males and upon observing the police the group of males split up and fled on foot in different directions as the uniformed officers pursued them on foot.

Ofc. Potter alone pursued Dcoris Toland (male, DOB) on foot behind the apartment buildings on Allen Temple Court NW and Dooris Toland tripped and fell while Ofc. Potter was running after him (this occurred approximately 40 seconds into the foot pursuit). After Dcoris Toland fell in the grassy area behind the apartment buildings, Ofc. Potter was able to catch up to him and Ofc. Potter verbally ordered Dcoris Toland to "get down," and to show his hands. Dcoris Toland returned to his feet and turned away from Ofc. Potter and began walking off and did not comply with Ofc. Potter's orders. Ofc. Potter pulled Dcoris Toland to the ground in a controlled manner as Dcoris Toland physically resisted arrest and refused to follow commands. Ofc. Potter repeatedly ordered Dcoris Toland to put his hands behind his back. Dcoris Toland, while kneeling on the ground and facing downwards, continued to try to stand up and kept pulling his arms and hands towards the front of his body and towards his waist. Dooris Toland then rolled onto his back and with his right hand he clenched at the front waistband of his red colored shorts near where a pistol was clipped onto his shorts. Ofc. Potter gained control of Dcoris Toland's left hand as Dcoris Toland continued to physically resist arrest. As Ofc. Potter tried to roll Dcoris Toland back into a prone position, Dcoris Toland attempted to sit upright. Ofc. Potter removed his handcuffs and with his handcuffs held inside of his closed right hand, Ofc. Potter struck Dcoris Toland twice on the left side of his face while ordering him multiple times to turn over and to surrender his hands (note: per Ofc. Potter's BWC footage, he had used his right hand to deploy the strikes and his handcuffs were palmed in his right hand at the time. No part of the metal handcuff appeared to have contacted Dcoris Toland's face). Ofc. Potter was then able to gain some control of the left wrist of Dcoris Toland and he placed a handcuff on the left wrist. Ofc. Potter continued to order Dcoris Toland to "turn over" in order to be handcuffed but Toland would not surrender his right arm / hand. Ofc. Potter then utilized two additional compliance strikes (no object in his hand) to the left side of Dcoris Toland's head and upper body area as Dcoris Toland rolled onto his front side and pulled his left hand (which was already handcuffed) away from Ofc. Potter

and towards the front of his body. Ofc. Potter grabbed the back of Dcoris Toland's head as Ofc. McCants (APEX) arrived to assist (Ofc. McCants arrives approximately 1 minute and 10 seconds after Ofc. Potter first physically made contact with Dcoris Toland). Dcoris Toland continues to physically resist, pulling his arms away from both of the officers towards his front waist area, and he does not obey the orders of either Ofc. Potter or Ofc. McCants. After approximately 45 seconds of struggling by Ofc. Potter and Ofc. McCants, Dcoris Toland is handcuffed behind his back. Both Ofc. Potter and Ofc. McCants are breathing heavy from the physical struggle with Dcoris Toland. Dcoris Toland is then rolled onto his side and Ofc. K. Craddock arrives and removes the pistol that is clipped to the front waistband of Dcoris Toland's shorts. The pistol is a loaded Glock 9mm which was determined to have been stolen (per an NCIC query) out of South Fulton. Per the police report. Dcoris Toland was later interviewed and claimed that he was just holding the pistol for another person but did not provide a name.

After his arrest, Dcoris Toland was examined by EMS and transported to Grady Detention with complaints of back pain, jaw pain, wrist pain and vomiting. Visible injuries were minor scratches / lacerations. Ofc. Potter completed a police report under case number 231641639 and Dcoris Toland was charged with Theft by Receiving Stolen Property and Willful Obstruction of Law Enforcement (felony). Ofc. Potter's supervisor completed a Use of Force report and determined that the defensive tactics used by Ofc. Potter (compliance strikes) were justified based on the totality of circumstances (armed subject actively resisting). In addition, the Training Academy reviewed the incident and determined that Ofc. Potter's use of compliance strikes was not excessive based on the circumstances and that the handcuffs being held by Ofc. Potter when he administered the strikes were in his palm and did not appear to make contact with Dcoris Toland's face though it was possible that a strand of the handcuff may have made contact with Dcoris Toland.

On 06/14/23 Ms. Sheena Weaver filed a telephonic complaint with OPS alleging that Dcoris Toland was physically beaten by several APD officers. On 06/16/23 Ms. Weaver filed an identical OPS complaint using the online portal (APD0002312) alleging that Ofc. Potter struck Dooris Toland in the face with handcuffs and that Toland sustained scratches to his face and a bloodied mouth due to the incident. The complaints were opened as this file (23-C-0332-UAF) for an allegation of Unnecessary Force against Ofc. Potter.

RECOMMENDED INVESTIGATIVE DISPOSITION:

Of the Complaint against: Officer Melvin Potter

APD.SOP.2010 Work Rules -

4.2.50 Maltreatment or Unnecessary Force

1. Employees are expressly prohibited from the unnecessary or unreasonable use of force against any person or property.

RULE 2. Employees shall only use that force which is reasonable and necessary to affect an arrest, prevent an escape, necessarily restrict the movement of a prisoner, defend himself/herself or another from physical assault, or to accomplish other lawful objectives. The reasonableness inquiry refers to whether the employee's actions are "objectively reasonable" in light of the facts and circumstances confronting him or her, without regard to their underlying intent or motivation. The "reasonableness" of a particular use of force must be judged from the perspective of a reasonable officer on the scene, and its calculus must embody an allowance for the fact that police officers are often forced to make split second decisions about the amount of force necessary in a particular situation.

Recommended Disposition Exonerated

Supporting Facts:

Ofc. Potter provided an employee statement to OPS on 07/12/23. A summary of his statement is below. A complete transcript along with an audio recording of Ofc. Potter's OPS statement is part of this OPS file.

Ofc. Potter stated that on 06/13/23 he and other APEX officers attempted to contact a group of males which the Gang Unit had indicated (via surveillance) were engaged in possible illegal drug use and that the males had run off as soon as they observed the APEX officers approaching. Ofc. Potter stated that the males ran different directions, and he followed one of the males, later identified as Dcoris Toland. While chasing Dooris Toland on foot, Dooris Toland fell down and Ofc. Potter ordered him to stay down. Ofc. Potter stated to OPS, "I was telling him to stay down cause he was getting up after he tripped. So I told him to stay down and, um, he didn't listen." Dooris Toland did not comply with orders and physically resisted Ofc. Potter. During his OPS statement Ofc. Potter stated, "...I'm trying to get his wrists and his arms and turn him over, telling him to turn over, telling him to gimme his hands. He's just not doing it. And he kept, um, he kept motioning towards his shorts. Um, uh, in the 78 (description) that was given out the, um, the intel, they said that, um, a couple of them were possibly armed that they had bulges coming out of their pants. And then during that is when I did see his bulge. Um, I saw the bulge and, and I could also see the, um, the handle poking out." Ofc. Potter became aware that Dcoris Toland had a pistol in his waistband near his right front hip and that the pistol was not in a holster but was rather clipped onto the pair of shorts being worn by Dcoris Toland. Ofc. Potter stated that Dcoris Toland used his hands to grab near where the firearm was located more than once while he physically resisted arrest.

When questioned by OPS regarding the strikes utilized while attempting to arrest Dcoris Toland, Ofc. Potter described that he struck Dcoris Toland in the face / head area to gain compliance. Prior to the compliance strikes, Ofc. Potter had observed that Decoris Toland begun looking around to see who else was nearby and Ofc. Potter feared for his safety and believed that Toland was about to escalate. Ofc. Potter stated that his fist covered his handcuffs and that his handcuffs did not touch Dcoris Toland's face during the compliance strikes. Ofc. Potter's handcuffs were in his hand because he was attempting to arrest and handcuff Dcoris Toland at the time.

During his OPS statement, Ofc. Potter indicated that Dcoris Toland, by his estimate, was approximately 6'01" to 6'02" in height and 280 to 300 pounds. Ofc. Potter is approximately 175 pounds and shorter in height than Dcoris Toland.

Ofc. Potter stated that he did not observe any lacerations to Dcoris Toland's face after Dcoris Toland was in custody and stated that Toland was transported to Grady Hospital as a precautionary measure because he had vomited after being arrested.

The allegation of a violation of APD.SOP.2010 Work Rules, 4.2.50 Maltreatment or Unnecessary Force, by Ofc. Potter was investigated and the recommended disposition is exoneration. The force used by Ofc. Potter was appropriate given the circumstances (larger in size armed male physically fighting and grabbing towards his firearm) and there is no indication that the handcuffs which Ofc. Potter held in his palm were intentionally utilized as a striking weapon.

Complainant Sheena Weaver filed a filed a telephonic OPS complaint on 06/14/23 alleging that Dcoris Toland was physically beaten by several APD officers. On 06/16/23 Ms. Weaver filed an identical OPS complaint using the online portal (APD0002312) alleging that Ofc. Potter struck Dcoris Tolan in the face with handcuffs and that Toland sustained scratches to his face and a bloodied mouth due to the incident. (Note: Ms. Weaver states that the subjects name is D'Ckari Toland in her online complaint). The narrative of Ms. Weaver's online complaint reads:

Officers were chasing some other people when D'Ckari (Ckari) exited the car and start running towards the building where we were hanging to grab something. He was caught in the mix of them pursuing others who he was not with. Officer ran him down and attacked him. Officer was hitting him and Ckari stated he was being hit with the cuffs but the officer replied nawl it was all fists. Which I may add sound like a reply of an arrogant officer with a chip on his young shoulder. As I looked at the officer fist he has no redness or bruises to signify he hit with his hands which shows he was hitting him in his face with cuffs. Ckari wasn't doing anything to deserve being physically assaulted by this officer. Ckari was arrested and transported to Grady hospital for care due to his injuries. His face had scratches, his mouth was bleeding and he stated his jaw was hurting as they transported him to police car from around the building. This isn't the 1st time an officer have assaulted him with excessive force without reason. It is time to speak up for many they do this all the time in our neighborhood and everyone in the hood isn't bad people.

On 08/28/23 I (Sgt. Buckley) attempted phone contact with Ms. Weaver at the she number provided to OPS and received no answer. A voice message was left. On 08/29/23 I attempted phone contact with Ms. Weaver a second time and Ms. Weaver returned my call (recorded). Ms. Weaver advised that she attempted to obtain copies of the BWC footage from the arrest of Dcoris Toland, but she was not able to receive copies due to the case being an active investigation at the time. Ms. Weaver indicated that she would attempt to gather cell phone videos from citizens who were at the scene and she would provide the videos to me. Ms. Weaver was provided my city email address. Ms. Weaver was not a direct witness to the incident. If Ms. Weaver provides any video recordings or images to OPS, the items will be reviewed and added to this OPS file. On 08/16/23 Ofc. K. Craddock provided an employee statement to OPS. Excerpts from her OPS statement are below. A complete transcript along with the audio recording of Ofc. Craddock's OPS statement is part of this file.

When asked about the detail at the Allen Temple Apartments on 06/13/23, Ofc. Craddock stated, "Officer Potter was my partner that day. Um, we were, we were advised by the plain clothes officers that there were about four to five black males smoking marijuana on the stoop, I guess is what you would call it for lack of better terms. So when Officer Potter and I, he was driving, I was in the passenger seat. When we pulled up and got out of the vehicle, they began to run, when they ran, and by that time other officers were on scene as well. They ran through like the breezeway of the apartment complex. I ran around the building just to see if I could catch different eyes. I was also told you don't run, stay right behind him. So I went around the building. By then Officer Potter like began to pass me and he was chasing an individual. I saw, after he, after I, excuse me, after I noticed he was chasing him, I saw another guy cut up. I, I went that way. And then when I realized I, there was no way I was gonna catch him, I came back down. I, Officer McCants kind of had met up with me at that point and she ran down to assist Officer Potter. All I saw was that there was a male struggling on the ground. Officer Potter was telling him to, you know, put his hands behind his back. Officer McCants then went up, tried to like, assist with grabbing his hands. When I came down the hill, they told me that the guy had a gun. I asked him where the gun was, he says in the, his front. So I just like, they leaned him over. I grabbed a gun. I, it was a pistol with a clip, like clipped onto his pants." Ofc. Craddock further stated, "Officer Potter was trying to like, get him in handcuffs and the guy had, I don't, I don't remember what was going on with his right arm, but his left arm was under him, like in front of him. And they said he was trying to reach for a gun. So his right, his, when I, when I first came down, his right arm was under him by the time Officer McCants got down there, which was seconds before I did, his arm was out. And so then when they told me that he had a gun, that's when I got it."

When asked if the pistol she retrieved from Dcoris Toland's waistband was in a holster, Ofc. Craddock stated, "No. So it was just, it, they had like drilled a clip, I guess you could say. I don't know. I don't know terminology. But they had, it was like a clip that you would like clip onto anything. They had drilled it onto the side and it was just clipped onto his, uh, he had shorts on." Ofc. Craddock also described that the trigger of the gun was not covered and was exposed and that she cleared the firearm to make and safe and found that the pistol was loaded.

Ofc. Craddock was not present when Ofc. Potter used compliance strikes on Dcoris Toland. When asked about any injuries to Dcoris Toland which she had observed, Ofc. Craddock stated, "I know that he had like some scrapes. He complained that, he complained a lot of different things was hurting 'cause I actually was down at Grady with him. He said that his jaw hurt. He said that his hip hurt and he some, something with his leg he was saying was hurting as well."



6/13/23 At approximately 6:55pm I Officer Potter and other Atlanta Police units were conducting surveillance in the Allen Temple neighborhood. 4 males were observed smoking Marijuana near the front of the complex.

Myself and units 1856 and 1866 arrived on scene to further investigate the illegal activities, Immediately upon our arrival the 4 males in question began to display furtive movements as we approached them. All males began Walking away from us ignoring commands to stop. They then began to run all in different directions. I pursued Mr Dcoris Toland for about a 30 seconds through the apartment complex. Mr Toland continued to ignore verbal commands to stop running but refused.

After catching up to Mr Toland, he was asked to put his hands behind his back. He refused and contined to try to evade me. Because of his refusal to follow lawful orders I decided to perform a takedown on Mr Toland in an effort to gain compliance and take him into custody,

While on the ground Mr Toland still refused to follow my orders to put his hands behind his back. He began to reach for his front right waistband, at this point I was able to see a bulge in his shorts to which I believed to be a gun based on my knowledge training and experience as an Atlanta Police Officer.

At this point after realizing that he was in possession of a firearm I asked Mr Toland again to stop resisting and to give me his hands or I would be forced to strike him. He still refused my orders thus resulting in me striking Mr Toland in his facial region in an effort to gain compliance in an attempt not to further escalate any Use of Force options. It was during this time another unit came to assist me in getting Mr Tolands hands away from his waistband so that he could be safely taken into custody.

After checking the Glock45 9mm off of him and running the serial number (BWDM787) through ACIC it was found that the weapon was stolen out of South Fulton PD. Case # 2022-019920 in a vehicle break in. After being Mirandized, Mr Toland was asked how he obtained the firearm. He advised that he was "holding it for someone" but could not advise who that someone was.

Furthermore, after a background check was done on Mr Toland it was found that he is a documented member of PFK and Goodfellas gang organization. Also, This is Mr Toland's second time being caught in possession of a stolen firearm. The first time being in 2021. Atlanta Police Department case # 211041241. After speaking to all parties involved in this particular case, Investigators found that Mr Toland lied about how he obtained the firearm.

Mr Toland was taken to Grady Detention after complaining of pain in his wrist, jaw and lower back. After he was discharged from Grady I transported him to Fulton County Jail.

Nothing further to report at this time.



These injuries were treated by Grady units on scene however, the subject was transported to Grady due to throwing up in the presence of Police. The review of Officer Potter's BWC was consistent with the events described by Officer Potter. I find that Officer Potter's actions were justified to protect himself, officers on scene and residents in the area.

According to APD.SOP.2020 your responsibilities, restrictions, and rights as an employee are:

3.4 Employee Responsibilities

All employees must answer questions and/or make available any relevant materials or sworn statements concerning an investigation of employee misconduct when directed to do so by a disciplinary authority or duly appointed investigator. Employees will provide all relevant information and materials and answer all questions honestly, completely, and to the best of their ability. An employee's refusal to cooperate and provide sworn statements, answers, or relevant materials during an authorized administrative investigation will result in disciplinary action, up to and including dismissal.

Any employee reporting for duty under the influence of any substance such as prescription medications, alcohol, over the counter medications, or other substances that, while legal, may adversely affect the judgment or performance of that employee during duty hours, must notify his or her immediate supervisor prior to commencing work.

3.5 Employee Restrictions

Except as authorized, in an investigation into employee misconduct, employees may not:

Interfere with the complaint investigation in any manner

Independently participate in the investigation

Be present during any investigative contact with a complainant or with witness involved in the investigation

Contact the complainant or witness concerning the allegations; or

Discuss the existence or facts of a complaint with anyone except designated Department authorities conducting the investigation. This restriction will not be construed to prohibit an employee from discussing any aspects of a complaint with his or her attorney or other representative, or to prevent his or her attorney from developing information for his or her defense.

3.6 Employee Rights

All employees have the right to have an attorney or other representative present during questioning in an administrative investigation. However, any employee who is either an accused employee or a witness in a complaint investigation may not act in the capacity of representative for any other employee being questioned as an accused or witness in that complaint investigation. An employee's representative shall be allowed to consult with the employee, and to object to questions, but shall not delay or interfere with the questioning process. Any objections to the form or content of the questions will be noted, but the employee shall still be required to answer fully and completely any and all questions presented during the investigation. An employee cannot delay questioning for more than three hours beyond the time he or she was given notice to appear for the questioning.

The employee being questioned as the accused will be issued the Written Notice of Allegations form (Form APD 848), which includes, but is not limited to a written statement of the allegation(s) and the employee's rights and responsibilities relative to the

investigation against him/her prior to any questioning.

All employees who are subject to any form of discipline, whether non-adverse or adverse action, will be given written documentation of the disciplinary action taken. This written documentation must state the work rule which applies to the disciplinary action taken, information and/or documentation supporting the alleged work rule violation, and the disciplinary action that was taken. Employees must sign the written documentation stating that they have been notified of the disciplinary action taken. The employee's signature does not constitute an admission of guilt or wrongdoing, it serves only as receipt of the written documentation of disciplinary action and notification of the same.

The employee against whom a complaint has been filed may review the investigative folder upon completion of that investigation. The OPS commander will designate the area where the folder is to be reviewed and establish rules governing the review of the folder.

If the employee is being questioned as a suspect in a criminal investigation, the employee will be afforded complete Miranda Rights.

Administrative statements made by employees and evidence gained as a result of such statements shall not be used against the employee in criminal proceedings involving the employee except in cases of perjury.
