3.4 Employee Responsibilities

All employees must answer questions and/or make available any relevant materials or sworn statements concerning an investigation of employee misconduct when directed to do so by a disciplinary authority or duly appointed investigator. Employees will provide all relevant information and materials and answer all questions honestly, completely, and to the best of their ability. An employee's refusal to cooperate and provide sworn statements, answers, or relevant materials during an authorized administrative investigation will result in disciplinary action, up to and including dismissal.

Any employee reporting for duty under the influence of any substance such as prescription medications, alcohol, over the counter medications, or other substances that, while legal, may adversely affect the judgment or performance of that employee during duty hours, must notify his or her immediate supervisor prior to commencing work.

3.5 Employee Restrictions

Except as authorized, in an investigation into employee misconduct, employees may not:

Interfere with the complaint investigation in any manner

Independently participate in the investigation

Be present during any investigative contact with a complainant or with witness involved in the investigation

Contact the complainant or witness concerning the allegations; or

Discuss the existence or facts of a complaint with anyone except designated Department authorities conducting the investigation. This restriction will not be construed to prohibit an employee from discussing any aspects of a complaint with his or her attorney or other representative, or to prevent his or her attorney from developing information for his or her defense.

3.6 Employee Rights

All employees have the right to have an attorney or other representative present during questioning in an administrative investigation. However, any employee who is either an accused employee or a witness in a complaint investigation may not act in the capacity of representative for any other employee being questioned as an accused or witness in that complaint investigation. An employee's representative shall be allowed to consult with the employee, and to object to questions, but shall not delay or interfere with the questioning process. Any objections to the form or content of the questions will be noted, but the employee shall still be required to answer fully and completely any and all questions presented during the investigation. An employee cannot delay questioning for more than three hours beyond the time he or she was given notice to appear for the questioning. The employee being questioned as the accused will be issued the Written Notice of Allegations form (Form APD 848), which

includes, but is not limited to a written statement of the allegation(s) and the employee's rights and responsibilities relative to the investigation against him/her prior to any questioning.

All employees who are subject to any form of discipline, whether non-adverse or adverse action, will be given written documentation of the disciplinary action taken. This written documentation must state the work rule which applies to the disciplinary action taken, information and/or documentation supporting the alleged work rule violation, and the disciplinary action that was taken. Employees must sign the written documentation stating that they have been notified of the disciplinary action taken. The employee's signature does not constitute an admission of guilt or wrongdoing, it serves only as receipt of the written documentation of disciplinary action and notification of the same.

The employee against whom a complaint has been filed may review the investigative folder upon completion of that investigation. The OPS commander will designate the area where the folder is to be reviewed and establish rules governing the review of the folder.

If the employee is being questioned as a suspect in a criminal investigation, the employee will be afforded complete Miranda Rights.

Administrative statements made by employees and evidence gained as a result of such statements shall not be used against the employee in criminal proceedings involving the employee except in cases of perjury.

Employees will provide all relevant information and materials and answer all questions honestly, completely, and to the best of their ability. An employee's refusal to cooperate and provide sworn statements, answers, or relevant materials during an authorized administrative investigation will result in disciplinary action, up to and including dismissal.

Any employee reporting for duty under the influence of any substance such as prescription medications, alcohol, over the counter medications, or other substances that, while legal, may adversely affect the judgment or performance of that employee during duty hours, must notify his or her immediate supervisor prior to commencing work.

3.5 Employee Restrictions

Except as authorized, in an investigation into employee misconduct, employees may not:

Interfere with the complaint investigation in any manner

Independently participate in the investigation

Be present during any investigative contact with a complainant or with witness involved in the investigation

Contact the complainant or witness concerning the allegations; or

Discuss the existence or facts of a complaint with anyone except designated Department authorities conducting the investigation. This restriction will not be construed to prohibit an employee from discussing any aspects of a complaint with his or her attorney or other representative, or to prevent his or her attorney from developing information for his or her defense.

3.6 Employee Rights

All employees have the right to have an attorney or other representative present during questioning in an administrative investigation. However, any employee who is either an accused employee or a witness in a complaint investigation may not act in the capacity of representative for any other employee being questioned as an accused or witness in that complaint investigation. An employee's representative shall be allowed to consult with the employee, and to object to questions, but shall not delay or interfere with the questioning process. Any objections to the form or content of the questions will be noted, but the employee shall still be required to answer fully and completely any and all questions presented during the investigation. An employee cannot delay questioning for more than three hours beyond the time he or she was given notice to appear for the questioning.

The employee being questioned as the accused will be issued the Written Notice of Allegations form (Form APD 848), which includes, but is not limited to a written statement of the allegation(s) and the employee's rights and responsibilities relative to the investigation against him/her prior to any questioning.

All employees who are subject to any form of discipline, whether non-adverse or adverse action, will be given written documentation of the disciplinary action taken. This written documentation must state the work rule which applies to the disciplinary action taken, information and/or documentation supporting the alleged work rule violation, and the disciplinary action that was taken. Employees must sign the written documentation stating that they have been notified of the disciplinary action taken. The employee's signature does not constitute an admission of guilt or wrongdoing, it serves only as receipt of the written documentation of disciplinary action and notification of the same.

The employee against whom a complaint has been filed may review the investigative folder upon completion of that investigation. The OPS commander will designate the area where the folder is to be reviewed and establish rules governing the review of the folder.

If the employee is being questioned as a suspect in a criminal investigation, the employee will be afforded complete Miranda Rights.

Administrative statements made by employees and evidence gained as a result of such statements shall not be used against the employee in criminal proceedings involving the employee except in cases of perjury.

All employees must answer questions and/or make available any relevant materials or sworn statements concerning an investigation of employee misconduct when directed to do so by a disciplinary authority or duly appointed investigator. Employees will provide all relevant information and materials and answer all questions honestly, completely, and to the best of their ability. An employee's refusal to cooperate and provide sworn statements, answers, or relevant materials during an authorized administrative investigation will result in disciplinary action, up to and including dismissal.

Any employee reporting for duty under the influence of any substance such as prescription medications, alcohol, over the counter medications, or other substances that, while legal, may adversely affect the judgment or performance of that employee during duty hours, must notify his or her immediate supervisor prior to commencing work.

3.5 Employee Restrictions

Except as authorized, in an investigation into employee misconduct, employees may not:

Interfere with the complaint investigation in any manner

Independently participate in the investigation

Be present during any investigative contact with a complainant or with witness involved in the investigation

Contact the complainant or witness concerning the allegations; or

Discuss the existence or facts of a complaint with anyone except designated Department authorities conducting the investigation. This restriction will not be construed to prohibit an employee from discussing any aspects of a complaint with his or her attorney or other representative, or to prevent his or her attorney from developing information for his or her defense.

3.6 Employee Rights

All employees have the right to have an attorney or other representative present during questioning in an administrative investigation. However, any employee who is either an accused employee or a witness in a complaint investigation may not act in the capacity of representative for any other employee being questioned as an accused or witness in that complaint investigation. An employee's representative shall be allowed to consult with the employee, and to object to questions, but shall not delay or interfere with the questioning process. Any objections to the form or content of the questions will be noted, but the employee shall still be required to answer fully and completely any and all questions presented during the investigation. An employee cannot delay questioning for more than three hours beyond the time he or she was given notice to appear for the questioning.

The employee being questioned as the accused will be issued the Written Notice of Allegations form (Form APD 848), which includes, but is not limited to a written statement of the allegation(s) and the employee's rights and responsibilities relative to the investigation against him/her prior to any questioning.

All employees who are subject to any form of discipline, whether non-adverse or adverse action, will be given written documentation of the disciplinary action taken. This written documentation must state the work rule which applies to the disciplinary action taken, information and/or documentation supporting the alleged work rule violation, and the disciplinary action that was taken. Employees must sign the written documentation stating that they have been notified of the disciplinary action taken. The employee's signature does not constitute an admission of guilt or wrongdoing, it serves only as receipt of the written documentation of disciplinary action and notification of the same.

The employee against whom a complaint has been filed may review the investigative folder upon completion of that investigation. The OPS commander will designate the area where the folder is to be reviewed and establish rules governing the review of the folder.

If the employee is being questioned as a suspect in a criminal investigation, the employee will be afforded complete Miranda

Administrative statements made by employees and evidence gained as a result of such statements shall not be used against the employee in criminal proceedings involving the employee except in cases of perjury.

Employees will provide all relevant information and materials and answer all questions honestly, completely, and to the best of their ability. An employee's refusal to cooperate and provide sworn statements, answers, or relevant materials during an authorized administrative investigation will result in disciplinary action, up to and including dismissal.

Any employee reporting for duty under the influence of any substance such as prescription medications, alcohol, over the counter medications, or other substances that, while legal, may adversely affect the judgment or performance of that employee during duty hours, must notify his or her immediate supervisor prior to commencing work.

3.5 Employee Restrictions

Except as authorized, in an investigation into employee misconduct, employees may not:

Interfere with the complaint investigation in any manner

Independently participate in the investigation

Be present during any investigative contact with a complainant or with witness involved in the investigation

Contact the complainant or witness concerning the allegations; or

Discuss the existence or facts of a complaint with anyone except designated Department authorities conducting the investigation. This restriction will not be construed to prohibit an employee from discussing any aspects of a complaint with his or her attorney or other representative, or to prevent his or her attorney from developing information for his or her defense.

3.6 Employee Rights

All employees have the right to have an attorney or other representative present during questioning in an administrative investigation. However, any employee who is either an accused employee or a witness in a complaint investigation may not act in the capacity of representative for any other employee being questioned as an accused or witness in that complaint investigation. An employee's representative shall be allowed to consult with the employee, and to object to questions, but shall not delay or interfere with the questioning process. Any objections to the form or content of the questions will be noted, but the employee shall still be required to answer fully and completely any and all questions presented during the investigation. An employee cannot delay questioning for more than three hours beyond the time he or she was given notice to appear for the questioning. The employee being questioned as the accused will be issued the Written Notice of Allegations form (Form APD 848), which

includes, but is not limited to a written statement of the allegation(s) and the employee's rights and responsibilities relative to the investigation against him/her prior to any questioning.

All employees who are subject to any form of discipline, whether non-adverse or adverse action, will be given written documentation of the disciplinary action taken. This written documentation must state the work rule which applies to the disciplinary action taken, information and/or documentation supporting the alleged work rule violation, and the disciplinary action that was taken. Employees must sign the written documentation stating that they have been notified of the disciplinary action taken. The employee's signature does not constitute an admission of guilt or wrongdoing, it serves only as receipt of the written documentation of disciplinary action and notification of the same.

The employee against whom a complaint has been filed may review the investigative folder upon completion of that investigation. The OPS commander will designate the area where the folder is to be reviewed and establish rules governing the review of the folder.

If the employee is being questioned as a suspect in a criminal investigation, the employee will be afforded complete Miranda Rights.

Administrative statements made by employees and evidence gained as a result of such statements shall not be used against the employee in criminal proceedings involving the employee except in cases of perjury.

An employee cannot delay questioning for more than three hours beyond the time he or she was given notice to appear for the questioning. The employee being questioned as the accused will be issued the Written Notice of Allegations form (Form APD 848), which

includes, but is not limited to a written statement of the allegation(s) and the employee's rights and responsibilities relative to the investigation against him/her prior to any questioning.

All employees who are subject to any form of discipline, whether non-adverse or adverse action, will be given written documentation of the disciplinary action taken. This written documentation must state the work rule which applies to the disciplinary action taken, information and/or documentation supporting the alleged work rule violation, and the disciplinary action that was taken. Employees must sign the written documentation stating that they have been notified of the disciplinary action taken. The employee's signature does not constitute an admission of guilt or wrongdoing, it serves only as receipt of the written documentation of disciplinary action and notification of the same.

The employee against whom a complaint has been filed may review the investigative folder upon completion of that investigation. The OPS commander will designate the area where the folder is to be reviewed and establish rules governing the review of the folder.

If the employee is being questioned as a suspect in a criminal investigation, the employee will be afforded complete Miranda Rights.

Administrative statements made by employees and evidence gained as a result of such statements shall not be used against the employee in criminal proceedings involving the employee except in cases of perjury.

According to APD SOP 2020 your responsibilities, restrictions, and rights as an employee are:

3.4 Employee Responsibilities

All employees must answer questions and/or make available any relevant materials or sworn statements concerning an investigation of employee misconduct when directed to do so by a disciplinary authority or duly appointed investigator. Employees will provide all relevant information and materials and answer all questions honestly, completely, and to the best of their ability. An employee's refusal to cooperate and provide sworn statements, answers, or relevant materials during an authorized administrative investigation will result in disciplinary action, up to and including dismissal.

Any employee reporting for duty under the influence of any substance such as prescription medications, alcohol, over the counter medications, or other substances that, while legal, may adversely affect the judgment or performance of that employee during duty hours, must notify his or her immediate supervisor prior to commencing work.

3.5 Employee Restrictions

Except as authorized, in an investigation into employee misconduct, employees may not:

Interfere with the complaint investigation in any manner

Independently participate in the investigation

Be present during any investigative contact with a complainant or with witness involved in the investigation

Contact the complainant or witness concerning the allegations; or

Discuss the existence or facts of a complaint with anyone except designated Department authorities conducting the investigation. This restriction will not be construed to prohibit an employee from discussing any aspects of a complaint with his or her attorney or other representative, or to prevent his or her attorney from developing information for his or her defense.

3.6 Employee Rights

All employees have the right to have an attorney or other representative present during questioning in an administrative investigation. However, any employee who is either an accused employee or a witness in a complaint investigation may not act in the capacity of representative for any other employee being questioned as an accused or witness in that complaint investigation. An employee's representative shall be allowed to consult with the employee, and to object to questions, but shall not delay or interfere with the questioning process. Any objections to the form or content of the questions will be noted, but the employee shall still be required to answer fully and completely any and all questions presented during the investigation. An employee cannot delay questioning for more than three hours beyond the time he or she was given notice to appear for the questioning.

The employee being questioned as the accused will be issued the Written Notice of Allegations form (Form APD 848), which includes, but is not limited to a written statement of the allegation(s) and the employee's rights and responsibilities relative to the investigation against him/her prior to any questioning.

All employees who are subject to any form of discipline, whether non-adverse or adverse action, will be given written documentation of the disciplinary action taken. This written documentation must state the work rule which applies to the disciplinary action taken, information and/or documentation supporting the alleged work rule violation, and the disciplinary action that was taken. Employees must sign the written documentation stating that they have been notified of the disciplinary action taken. The employee's signature does not constitute an admission of guilt or wrongdoing, it serves only as receipt of the written documentation of disciplinary action and notification of the same.

The employee against whom a complaint has been filed may review the investigative folder upon completion of that investigation. The OPS commander will designate the area where the folder is to be reviewed and establish rules governing the review of the folder.

If the employee is being questioned as a suspect in a criminal investigation, the employee will be afforded complete Miranda Rights.

Administrative statements made by employees and evidence gained as a result of such statements shall not be used against the employee in criminal proceedings involving the employee except in cases of perjury.



Use of Force - Officer K. Kimbrough

I have reviewed the BWC footage of Officer Kimbrough's Use of Force that resulted in the death of the arrestee. Officer Kimbrough had probable cause to make the arrest once the arrestee wouldn't sign the traffic citation that resulted from a traffic accident. When Officer Kimbrough attempted to place the arrestee in handcuffs, the arrestee pulled his arm away from the officer's grasp. At that point Officer Kimbrough and the arrestee struggle briefly before Officer Kimbrough is able to get the suspect on the ground. Officer Kimbrough maintains a position of advantage and has physical control of the arrestee; however, he is unable to place the handcuffs on. Officer Kimbrough draws his taser and arcs it several times in an attempt, I assume, to encourage the arrestee to comply. Officer Kimbrough appears to drive stun the arrestee one time in the shoulder area, and then with the help of a bystander is able to handcuff the arrestee. At this point it seems it was recognized the arrestee was in some state of medical distress and first aid is administered.

While the level of resistance offered in this situation could justify the physical force and use of the taser, there are some concerns in determining if this use of force was reasonable and necessary. This was a traffic citation in a traffic accident, a very minor crime. The only need for the physical arrest was the refusal to sign the citation. The arrestee did offer active resistance by pulling away from the officers' grasp, but the Officer maintained physical control throughout the confrontation. This control would place in question if the officer was in danger at any point. The arrestee seemed to be elderly and even stated he was an old man; I can assume that Officer Kimbrough is a younger officer. Officer Kimbrough seemed to be in physical control during the confrontation and continued to give verbal commands, although some of his verbal commands were to sign the ticket. The arrestee complained several times that he could not breath, but these complaints came while Officer Kimbrough was actively attempting to handcuff the arrestee. The drive stun to attempt to use pain compliance is a method that has been taught by APD. Given these factors, the use of force may be reasonable, but it does not seem necessary. The severity of the crime coupled with the age of the arrestee factor into the force decision. Officer Kimbrough did not attempt any de-escalation techniques and did not seem to be in danger at any point. A supervisor had been requested and there were no safety concerns that necessitated the immediate hand cuffing of the arrestee,

The decision to use force has to be based on the objective reasonableness of the facts and circumstances facing the officer and how the officer perceives these facts and circumstances. Officer Kimbrough's statement and account of the confrontation will be very important in determining the justification of this use of force. The appearance of control and the lack of danger viewed on the BWC may not be what Officer Kimbrough perceived was happening. Absent his statement containing objectively reasonable perceptions not visible in the BWC footage, this force may be reasonable but it is not necessary making it outside of the use of force policy.




