



On November 20, 2019 at approximately 5:15 PM, I, Sheriff Robert Rodgers arrested a Wilcox County Deputy on narcotic related charges.

On November 20, 2019 at approximately 5:15 PM, I, Sheriff Robert Rodgers arrested Deputy James Carlile on narcotic related charges.

On October 3, 2019, I, Sheriff Rodgers, hired James Carlile, who was post certified and was currently working part time for Buena Vista Police Department as a police officer. Carlile, after being hired, ask if he could take off on October 25, 26, 27, 2019, to go out of town that had already been planned. I approved these days off. I have been informed that Carlile filled out his time sheet showing that he worked on October 26 and 27, 2019, a 12 hour shift on each day. Carlile did not work these two days. The time sheet was approved by mistake and Carlile was paid for the two day he didn't work.

When Deputy Carlile was hired, he was placed on a shift with Deputy Poss, with Poss being senior deputy on the shift. I was notified that in early November that Deputy Carlile was sneaking away approximately 30 minutes before his shift ended and was telling the night shift jail officer (Yancy) to call the Wilcox 911 center and have them put him off duty at 5:00 AM. I confronted Carlile about the issue and told him he would not be leaving early and being paid for it. Carlile advised me that it would not happen again.

I, Sheriff Rodgers, received a verbal complaint from Michael Stephens, who stated that his sister and a friend was traveling Ga. Hwy 280 into Rochelle and felt like a deputy was following them. Stephens stated that they pulled into the Marathon gas station in Rochelle and the deputy pulled into the parking lot behind them. Stephens stated that when the two females left the store the deputy also left out behind them. Stephens stated that several miles later, near Cleveland Ave in Pitts, the girls pulled over to ask the deputy why he was following them. Stephens stated that the deputy was rude and had his flashlight shining on the driver's breasts the whole time they were talking. Stephens stated that he was upset that a deputy would do that and one of the girls was his sister.

I decided because Deputy Carlile was still on his 90 day probationary status, I, was going to terminate him from the Wilcox County Sheriff's Office. During the week of November 4, 2019, I, Sheriff Rodgers, then received information that Deputy Carlile was inquiring about purchasing pills from an inmate at the Wilcox County Jail. The inmate was a trustee at the time.

On November 15, 2019, at approximately 2:00 PM, I, Sheriff Rodgers, interviewed inmate Larry Hatfield in reference to the information obtained. The interview was conducted in the Wilcox County Sheriff's Office with only Hatfield and myself present. Hatfield essentially stated the following:

Hatfield advised that Carlile asked him where he could get some pills. Hatfield stated he told Carlile he really didn't know but could ask around. Hatfield advised that Carlile wanted roxi 30's (roxicodone 30mg).

I allowed Hatfield to log onto his face book messenger to obtain text messages that his wife sent. Hatfield stated that Carlile was communicating with his wife to obtain the pills. Text attached.

The Wilcox County Sheriff's Office Drug Investigator Jay Williams, was notified of the issue. I advised Williams that I wanted him to make a case on Carlile if he was out trying to purchase narcotics.

On November 18, 2019 (unknown time), I, Sheriff Rodgers, received a phone call from Carlile stating that he had a death in the family and was wondering if he could have the day off. Carlile stated that if the body was not going to be released from the crime lab today he could come in. Carlile stated he would let me know.

Approximately 4:25 PM, Carlile texted me stating the body was not being released and he was on his way to work. Carlile's shift starts at 5:00 PM. Shortly after the text message, Carlile called and stated he had rear-ended a semi in Macon County and was going to the hospital. Carlile sent photo's of his vehicle and stated he couldn't come in to work. I advised Carlile just to let me know what was going on with him.

November 19, 2019, at approximately 1:40 PM, Carfile text me saying that he didnt think he would be at work saying he could not even get out of bed.

On November 20, 2019, at approximately 4:40 PM, I was notified by Investigator Williams that he was with the former inmate that Carlile was trying to purchase narcotics from. Williams stated that Carlile was in Wilcox County and was making a deal to purchase roxi's (roxicodone). Williams stated that Carlile was in a dark colored Toyota Camry in the parking lot of AV's (Sunoco) in Rochelle, waiting for the former inmate to bring him the drugs. Williams stated that he had the text messages and that was enough to charge Carlile with conspiracy to purchase narcotics.

I parked in front of the store two spaces from the blue Camry with one vehicle being between us. I stepped out of my Sheriff's Office vehicle and a Wilcox County citizen pulls up behind me with the driver wanting to speak to me. I stepped back to his vehicle and advised him that I would have to call him later.

I turned on my Sheriff's Office body camera (SN: H100685) as Carlile walked up to me. I asked Carlile what he was doing? Carlile stated he was heading home from moms house. I stated to Carlile that he and I need to talk. Carlile stated alright and ask what was going on. I ask what he was really doing here. Carlile stated heading home, really heading home, I promise. I stated to Carlile that was not my understanding. Carlile said HUH? I asked Carlile who he was waiting here to meet? Carlile stated his wife is in the gas station getting them a drink. I asked Carlile if he minded if I looked at his phone. Carlile stated you can. Carlile started reaching around in his pockets and stated that he didn't have his phone but had her phone. I asked who was texting Hatfield but got tongue twisted and stated who was texting Hatfield? I then stated you were texting Hatfield on whose phone, yours or hers? Carlile stated he wasn't texting Hatfield. Carlile then stated she, girlfriend, may have been texting Hatfield, but not me. I asked Carlile how does she know Hatfield? Carlile stated she met him one time up at the station. Carlile asked what was going on? I stated what was going on is why you are here. I stated to Carlile that he was here to buy dope from Hatfield. Carlile stated he's not buying dope. I advised Carlile to put his hands on my vehicle. Carlile turned around and placed his hands on my vehicle as he was told. I then told him to face me, and I handcuffed Carlile in front of his body. I advised Carlile I wasn't having this, that I trusted him to uphold the law here. Carlile stated he does uphold the law. I asked Carlile what he had on him (meaning what he had in his pockets) and started searching his pockets. Carlile had the Wilcox County Sheriff's Office badge on his belt. I took the Badge off and placed it in my pocket. Carlile stated he didn't have anything on him. Carlile stated he didn't have cash or anything on him. I asked Carlile what was his wife's name. Carlile stated Katie. I secured Carlile in the back of my Sheriff's Office vehicle.

On November 20, 2019 at approximately 5:17 PM, I, Sheriff Rodgers, made contact with female standing on the sidewalk in front of the store. I asked the female if she was Katie. She stated yeah. I asked Katie to step over here. Katie asked what was going on? I, asked Katie who was texting Hatfield you or him? Katie asked Who? I stated Hatfield, and then asked Katie where her phone was? Katie started digging in her purse and I asked Katie if Carlile has a phone? Katie stated yeah he's got one. Katie held up her phone. I asked Katie why they were here? Katie stated that she picked him up from Eastman from her mothers house. I asked Katie if that was her phone? Katie stated yes. I asked Katie if she had been texting anyone in the last few minutes? Katie stated no and pulled up where she had been texting her mom. Katie asked why? I stated to Katie, right now Carlile is under arrest. Katie asked for what? I advised Katie that he is sworn to uphold the law here and he's not going to come here and buy dope under my nose. I advised Katie that he was here right now to meet somebody to buy dope. Katie stated no. Katie stated he is not here to buy dope. I stated to Katie that I have the text messages to prove it. Katie stated that she picked him up from Eastman and they are going home. Katie asked if I had talked to him. I stated yes and he is denying it. I stated to Katie that I knew they were right here in a Camry. I asked how would I know that? Katie stated she did not know. Katie stated she didn't know a Hatfield. I stated to Katie that Carlile just told me that it was her that was texting Hatfield. I stated to Katie that Carlile said she knew Hatfield and he didn't. I corrected myself and stated that Katie knows him and I know that Carlile knows him. Katie then stated that maybe I could discuss this with him (Carlile) maybe he was doing something to try to help us (Sheriff's Office) out. Katie stated that he's an officer here. I stated to Katie not anymore because he's fired and under arrest. Katie stated that what she's saying is that maybe he was trying to help us out with something that was going on. I advised Katie to have a seat because I was going to search that car. Katie stated okay. At approximately 5:19 I advised Wilcox 911 that I had arrested a subject and during speaking to 911 over the radio Katie walked over to the drivers side of the vehicle and I had to tell her not to get in the car. Katie then walked back to the table on the sidewalk of the store. I called for Investigator Williams to be en-route to the store. Katie asked if she could call her mother. I told her that would be fine. Katie then asked if she could talk to Carlile and I advised her not now. Katie asked please and I stated no. I looked in the passenger side window of the vehicle and could see a cell phone in the center console cup holder. Katie then asked if I was the Sheriff and I told her I was. Katie asked again if she could please just talk to him. I told her no again. Katie asked if I had tried to talk to him about this. I advised her that I had and he denied it. Katie asked if she could go in and buy a pack of cigarettes. I advised sure. I did not limit Katie from anything but speaking to Carlile and entering the Camry.

Approximately 5:22 PM Rochelle Police Officer Ron Hollis arrived as back up. I placed a phone call to Investigator Mauldin to see if he was nearby. Investigator Williams called and I spoke to him and updated him of what had occurred at AV's gas station. Katie walked out to me in the parking lot and stated that she heard him talking to somebody on the phone earlier. I advised Katie that he was texting not talking. Katie then said she heard him texting, whatever, but she doesn't know what is going on with this. She stated she doesn't get involved with the medicine. Katie stated she picked him up from her morns house and they were going back home. Katie stated she remembers this guy being in jail, she thinks, but she doesn't know. Katie stated that he did mention Hatfield but she knows Carlile doesn't take whatever this dude is talking about. Katie stated she doesn't know what's going on. I advised Katie that it was said that he was getting them for her. Katie stated for me? and then stated no. Katie asked if her fiancé said that. I stated yeah. I stated to Katie that law enforcement officers are held to a higher standard and I wasn't going to have it. Katie agreed and stated, this cant be any kind of drug deal or something like that. Katie stated she doesn't know what he has told me or anything like that. I advised Katie that he would have an opportunity to tell his side of things. Katie advised that's what she wants but couldn't understand why she can't just talk to him. I told Katie that he was under arrest right now. Katie asked for what? I advised Katie, conspiracy to buy narcotics and that he is off duty right now. Katie stated exactly and he is an officer. I stated to Katie that was correct, therefore he's held to a higher standard than the average public. Katie told me to get his side of the story before I arrest him. I advised Katie that he is under arrest now and it isn't no before arresting him, that he is arrested now. Katie stated that I could stand over there while they talk. I again told Katie that she could not speak to Carlile. Katie asked if she would be able to talk to him. I stated that she would be able to talk to him at some point. I looked over at the Camry and Katie stated that I could search the car, that there aint nothing in her car. Katie then ask me what we were waiting on. I advised Katie that we are waiting on my drug investigator whose been handling the other side of this case.

Approximately 5:28 PM, I raised the back of my Sheriff's office vehicle hatch to retrieve an evidence bag for the cell phone I had seen in the cup holder inside the Camry. Carlile asked if I could loosen up on the cuffs on his wrist. I advised that I would. I opened the back door where Carlile was sitting and adjusted the cuffs.

Approximately 5:31, Investigator Williams arrived and I advised him that Carlile was in the passenger side of the Camry and that I saw him exit the vehicle. I advised Williams that Katie was driving but inside the store when I arrived. I briefed Williams on what had been said by Katie. Williams spoke to Katie for a few moments and Williams and I searched the Toyota Camry. I opened the passenger side door and saw cash in the door handle of the passenger door. I counted the money and found that it was \$140.00 in 20 dollar bills.

Approximately 5:45 PM, my body camera starts the 2nd recording file. (meaning that

this footage is on two different files)

Katie states that the cash in the door is her's and tells Williams that the phone is in Carlile's name. Katie states that the debit card in the door handle is her account but Carlile's card. Katie stated that she would appreciate if we would not take the money. I stated to Katie that we say he is here waiting to buy pills, with him being in the passenger seat with cash right there. Katie then states that it is his cash, that he didn't have it in his pocket. Williams then asked Katie how was he going to pay for the pills. Katie starts to say "something about" and then stops herself. Katie then said, dude I told you I don't know. Katie said he didn't discuss any of that with her. Williams and Katie had a conversation about her calling him "dude". Williams then told Katie that we are taking the money as evidence. I walked away again, and when I returned Katie again asked if she could see Carlile and I declined to let her see him again. Katie asked if she could call the D.A. and I advised her that he hasn't got the case yet. I then walked away to get a note pad to take down tag information and I.D. information on Katie. I then transported Carlile to the Wilcox County Jail for booking.

I stated there's Sheriff Rodgers over there with deputies out buying drugs!! Carlile stopped talking and sat quietly for a few moments and stated 'I don't know if this makes a difference, but I apologize. I stated to Carlile that it didn't. My body camera was not running at the time of this conversation.

ON 2/13/2020 AT APPROX 1400 I MET WITH REBEKAH STEPHENS AND BRITTANY CALHOUN AS REQUESTED BY SHERIFF RODGERS, REFERENCE AN INCIDENT WHICH OCCURRED IN NOV 2019 WITH DEPUTY CARLILE. A VIDEO OF THE INTERVIEWS WAS DONE. BOTH SUBJECTS STATED THAT THEY HAD BEEN TO EASTMAN TO MEET A GUY BRITTANY IS NOW DATING. ON THE WAY BACK SOMETIME AROUND MIDNIGHT, BRITTANY NOTICED THE OFFICER BEHIND HER NEAR THE KING OF KINGS INTERSECTION JUST OUTSIDE ROCHELLE. SHE HAD STOPPED IN ROCHELLE TO GET GAS AND THE OFFICER PULLED OVER TO TALK TO A POLICE OFFICER WHO WAS SITTING OUTSIDE THE STORE. SHE STATED SHE WAS LOOKING TRYING TO SEE WHO THE POLICE OFFICER WAS BUT COULDN'T IDENTIFY HIM. THEY BOTH STATED AFTER THEY LEFT THAT THE DEPUTY PULLED OUT AND BEGAN FOLLOWING THEM AGAIN TOWARDS CORDELE. AS THEY GOT NEAR PITTS SHE (BRITTANY) TOLD REBEKAH SHE WAS GOING TO TURN OFF AND SEE IF HE CONTINUED FOLLOWING. SHE TURNED ONTO CLEVELAND AVENUE AND THE DEPUTY PULLED OFF ALSO. SHE THEN PULLED OVER AND THE DEPUTY ACTIVATED HIS BLUE LIGHTS AND APPROACHED HER CAR. SHE STATED THEY HAD A CONVERSATION AND SHE WAS ADMITTINGLY AGITATED BECAUSE SHE WAS NOT DRINKING AND HADN'T DONE ANYTHING. HE HAD TOLD HER THAT SHE HAD GOT NEAR THE WHITE LINE AND THOUGHT SHE MIGHT BE DRINKING. DURING THE CONVERSATION BOTH WOMEN STATED THAT IT WAS OBVIOUS THE DEPUTY WAS SHINING HIS LIGHT DOWN HER SHIRT AT HER BREASTS. SHE WAS UNCOMFORTABLE ABOUT IT AND REBEKAH HAD CALLED HER BROTHER MICHAEL WHO CONTACTED THE SHERIFF. BOTH INTERVIEWS ARE ON VIDEO. PHOTO'S ARE ALSO ATTACHED THAT BRITTANY HAD TAKEN THAT NIGHT OF HER AND HER FRIEND REBEKKAH. THE DEPUTY IN QUESTION WAS DEPUTY CARLILE.
