Good afternoon, Mr. Blume. I'm in receipt of your request. Please reference the ORR# in the subject header in all future communications.

Global CAD search revealed 314 instances of CAD report involving DUI statewide, for all troopers. I'm trying to see if the software has a function that can refine the result into the search you want. Even the 314 result seems low, so the search may have issues we are not aware of at this time.

My next course of action is to contact the Post where Sgt. MacDonald is based and querying whether they keep a record of all DUI arrests he has made in 2024, which I am fairly certain they do. And from the list of his DUI incident report, I may have able to harvest the CAD report numbers. Please be advised that an incident report will have at least 1 CAD report, and the CAD reports are \$2 each, making it likely that the sum will exceed the \$25 threshold for asking for confirmation to pay.

Since this request involves querying the Post, waiting for a reply, and individually searching the responsive incident report to harvest the CAD numbers, with the possibility that the CAD numbers may have to be independently searched using the incident report number and the dates if the CAD numbers are not directly referenced in the incident reports, and then reviewing and editing the CAD reports that contain information that has to be redacted, the likely completion time for your request will greatly exceed the statutory 3 days. My best guess is 2 weeks. Please consider this email your notice of the same. OCGA 50-18-71(b)(1)(A).
