Thanks for the update. Release the incident report and the CAD report

You are the first agency to make an exemption on an incident report.

In Georgia, law enforcement agencies cannot categorically exempt incident reports from disclosure under the Open Records Act (O.C.G.A. § 50-18-70) just because a case is pending prosecution.

While certain portions of records may be withheld—such as active investigative files under O.C.G.A. § 50-18-72(a)(4)—incident reports are generally considered public records. Georgia courts have ruled that basic incident reports, which document the initial facts of an incident, are not the same as investigative reports and must be released.

“If an agency is withholding an incident report under the claim of pending prosecution, they must specifically justify why the report falls under an exemption. If you encounter this issue, you can challenge it by requesting a specific legal citation or filing a complaint with the Georgia Attorney General’s Office.”
