Before me, the undersigned authority and an investigator of the Louisville Metro Police Department's Professional Standard Unit came: [REDACTED] Who after being duly sworn, deposes and says: Officers had no reasonable suspicion/probable cause when they performed a traffic stop while [REDACTED] was attempting to change child's diaper behind grandmother's home. During the incident [REDACTED] was pulled from her vehicle and an unknown officer pulled her hair. [REDACTED] claims excessive force was used against her when she was unnecessarily taken to the ground. Once on the ground, an unknown officer stomped on her head 4 times, causing [REDACTED] to lose consciousness. [REDACTED] complains unknown officers would not allow her naked child to be properly clothed in the cold and is upset her child witnessed the altercation. [REDACTED] alleges Officer Straman made the discourteous comment of "Yahoo! At least I got one arrest tonight!" to an EMS worker. [REDACTED] complains she was searched illegally for contraband at the hospital and was never given her ID back. [REDACTED] further complains her vehicle was impounded even though she was not arrested.
